

NOVEMBER 12, 2023 32nd SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME "MY SOUL IS THIRTING FOR YOU, O LORD MY GOD" -Psalm 63

Today, in the Gospel of Matthew, we hear the parable of the wise and foolish bridesmaids. This parable is only found in the Gospel of Matthew and represents a part of the last words of teaching that Jesus shared in the Temple of Jerusalem. In the parable all the bridesmaids are awaiting the arrival of the groom. Jesus shared that five of the attendants foolishly do not bring enough oil for their lamps. Five bring extra oil for their lamps as they wait for the groom. The groom is



delayed, and only the lamps of the wise attendants are still burning in the late hour. Throughout the centuries, Christians have seen the image of the oil lamp as reflecting the blessings of our good deeds and actions that unite us to Jesus. Only by uniting our hearts and actions to Jesus can the flame of faithful service burn brightly. May we always be like to wise bridesmaids and be always ready and attentive to joyfully welcome Jesus into our hearts and lives.

May God-Father, Son, Holy Spirit-abundantly bless you and your families in the coming week!
