JANUARY 7, 2024 – THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD**“LORD, EVERY NATION ON EARTH WILL ADORE YOU.” – PSALM 72**

Today, the Church celebrates the Epiphany of the Lord. This is the day that we hear of the visit of the Magi – “The Three Kings” – to Jesus – the newborn king of the Jews – in Bethlehem. The word EPIPHANY is Greek and means “manifestation” or “made visible”. This day celebrates the joyful reality that in the visit of the Magi, travelers from a distant land, Jesus is made visible as more than just the Promised Messiah of the Jewish people. Jesus is the Savior of all peoples and all generations of the world. In Jesus, Jews and Gentiles all receive the invitation of grace and reunion with God for all of eternity. In many ways, this celebration of Epiphany represents the climax of the Christmas season. Epiphany is not an afterthought to the Christmas celebrations, but a reflection of the love of God poured out on all the world in the birth of Jesus. May our celebration of the revelation of Jesus, the Light of the World, made manifest by the visit of the Magi reflect and magnify the joy of the birth of the Savior that we celebrated on Christmas Day.

May God – Father, Son, Holy Spirit – abundantly bless you and your families in this coming week!

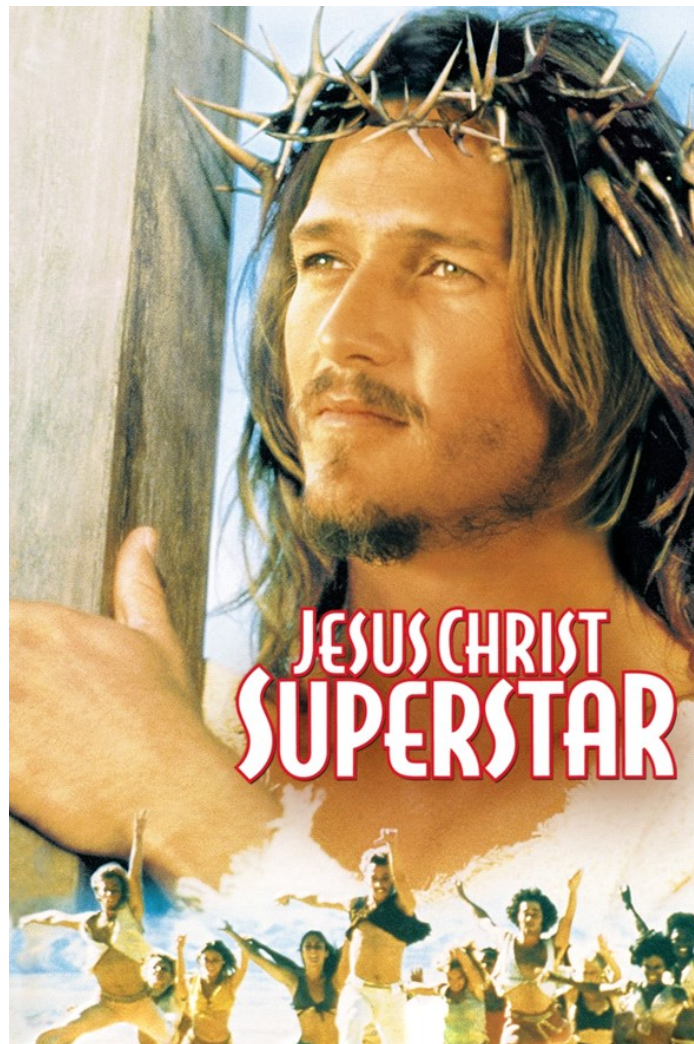

- Movie Night (e.g., Mother Teresa of Calcuta).

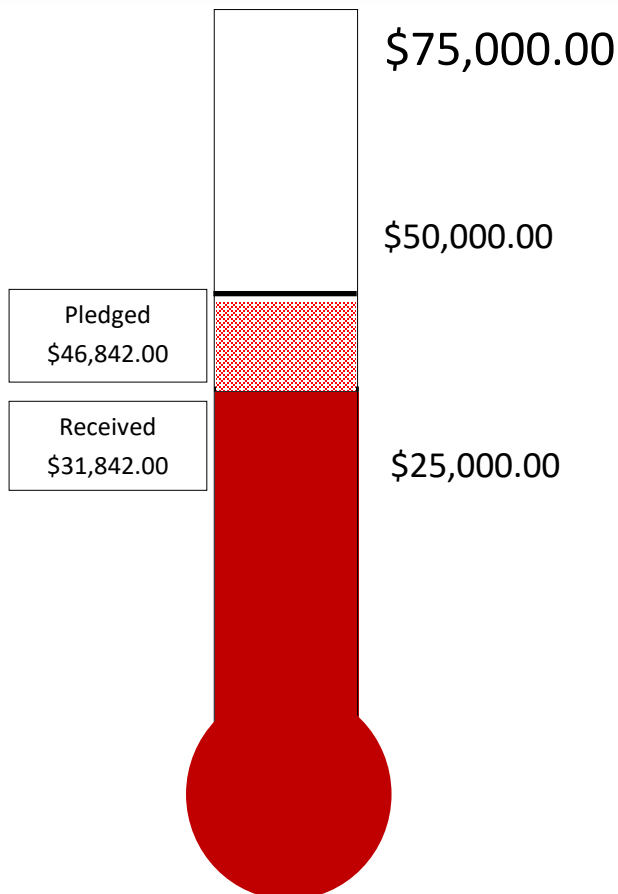
