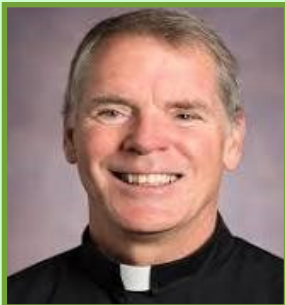
Today, in the Gospel of Mark, we hear of the first days of the public ministry of Jesus. The ministry begins with the small town of Capernaum located by the sea of Galilee. 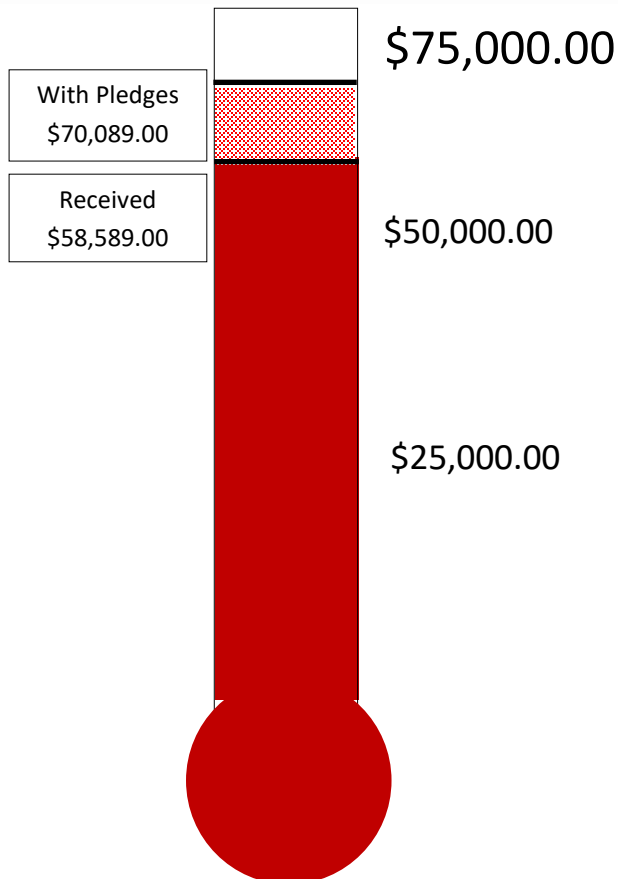
