

MARCH 17, 2024 – FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT "CREATE A CLEAN HEART IN ME, O GOD." – PSALM 51

Today, The Church celebrates the Fifth Sunday of Lent and Jesus shares that his hour of fulfillment has arrived. It is Passover, and Jesus has entered into Jerusalem in jubilant glory, welcomed as a king. Now he shares clearly with his apostles his calling as the Suffering Servant. Jesus shares the image of the grain of wheat falling to the ground to convey the reality of his coming suffering and death. Just as the grain of wheat falls to the ground to yield a rich harvest, Jesus will offer his life for the salvation of the world. The path to true eternal life is going to involve giving up earthly life. Jesus powerfully shares this reality, but not all can hear and understand clearly. May we be among those who hear Jesus with true clarity and understanding. May we always rejoice in the true and eternal victory over sin and death shared by Jesus as the Suffering Servant.


