

JUNE 29, 2025 – SAINTS PETER & PAUL

"THE ANGEL OF THE LORD WILL RESCUE THOSE WHO FEAR HIM."

This Sunday, June 29, 2025, the Church celebrates Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles. Each year on June 29th the Church celebrates these two great apostolic figures who are patrons of the Church in Rome. Saints Peter and Paul represent two very different leaders in temperament and in their relationship to Jesus as Lord and Savior, but both shared the ultimate calling of martyrdom in the city of Rome. Their calling to apostolic leadership reflects the reality that nothing is impossible for those whose lives are transformed by an encounter with Jesus.

The gospels share that Peter was among the first disciples who left all to follow Jesus. Peter heard the words of Jesus at Caesarea Philippi affirming his calling to shepherd the community of faith. Peter would experience the shame of denying Jesus three times on the night before the crucifixion. But Peter would experience the powerful gift of forgiveness offered by Jesus, the Risen Savior. On Pentecost, filled with the Holy Spirit, Peter was the first to proclaim the Good News of Salvation. Ultimately the Holy Spirit would lead Peter to shepherd the Christians of Rome and to offer his life in witness to his love for Jesus.

Paul never encountered or experienced the public ministry of Jesus. Paul, the self-righteous young man, would persecute and put to death the followers of The Way of Jesus. Paul experienced a dramatic moment of encounter with the Risen Jesus on the road to Damascus and would see his life completely transformed. The Holy Spirit inspired Paul to proclaim the Good News to all peoples, both Jew and Greek, slave and free, rich and poor. This zeal for the salvation of souls inspired the missionary fervor of Paul. This grace ultimately carried Paul to Rome and the offering all for Jesus,

Saints Peter and Paul, Holy Apostles of Jesus Christ. Pray for Us!

May God - Father, Son, Holy Spirit - abundantly bless your families in this upcoming week.
