

#### JULY 13, 2025 – FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME "TURN TO THE LORD IN YOUR NEED, AND YOU WILL LIVE." – PSALM 6

This Sunday, in the Gospel of Luke, we hear Jesus share the parable of the Good Samaritan. Jesus shares this dramatic parable in response to the question: "And who is my neighbor?" Jesus responds with a parable. Three people making the journey to Jericho see someone lying half-dead. The first two travelers, a priest and a Levite, see the man and pass by on the opposite side. They do not want to get involved. The third traveler to encounter the victim on the road is motivated by compassion. The actions of the Samaritan both rescue and heal the injured man. Jesus concludes the parable by asking: "Which of these three, in your opinion, was neighbor to the robbers' victim?" We are called to acknowledge that the actions of compassion speak much more loudly than our words. Only by acting with compassion can we truly reflect our calling as children of a most merciful and compassionate God. May we always live with a spirit of mercy and compassion, reflecting the compassion of Our Merciful Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

## PATRONS OF OUR PARISH

Our parish community, Saint Cyril, is named for and placed under the patronage of two saints, Cyril and Methodius, who were brothers and are called the "Apostles of the Slavic Peoples" of Central and Eastern Europe. Saint Methodius, the older of the two brothers, was born in the year 815 and Saint Cyril, the youngest of seven brothers, was born eleven years later in the year 826. Both brothers were born in the city of Thessalonica in what was a part of the Byzantine Empire. The city of Thessalonica traced its Christian roots back to the missionary preaching of Saint Paul. As young men, Methodius and Cyril were ordained as monastic priests. Beginning in the year 860, the brothers were requested by the Patriarch of Constantinople and the Pope, Patriarch of the West, to share the Gospel with the nomadic Slavic tribes settling in the lands of Central and Eastern Europe. Members of these Slavic tribes were pagans and had no written language. In order to translate the Bible and liturgical ritual books into the spoken language of the Slavic peoples, Saint Cyril developed an alphabet, based upon the Greek alphabet. The Cyrillic alphabet is still used by many languages today, most importantly Russian. The focus of the missionary work of Saint Cyril was the translation of texts. Saint Methodius, was appointed a bishop and had the missionary focus of establishing an ecclesial administrative structure among the tribes and lands of the Slavic peoples. Saints Cyril and Methodius were unique as missionary evangelists in that their efforts received the support of both the Pope and the Patriarch of Constantinople and formed a bridge between the leaders of the Churches of the East and West. The missionary efforts of these brothers, Cyril and Methodius, reflected the urgency of the missionary zeal of Western Christianity in taking the gospel to all peoples while also sharing the rich liturgical heritage of the Divine Liturgy, the Mass, of Eastern Christianity. Saint Cyril was the first of the two brothers to die. Saint Cyril, worn out by his labors, died on February 14, 869, while in Rome. Saint Methodius, serving as a bishop and establishing a strong Christian ecclesial presence in Central and Eastern Europe would continue the evangelizing mission until his death on April 6, 885, in Moravia. For their role in bringing the Gospel and evangelizing the peoples of Central and Eastern Europe Saints Cyril and Methodius are called the "APOSTLES Of THE SLAVIC PEOPLES."





