JULY 20, 2025 – SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME "HE WHO DOES JUSTICE WILL LIVE IN THE PRESENCE OF THE LORD."

This Sunday, in the Gospel of Luke, we hear of the events surrounding the visit of Jesus to the house of his friends, Martha and Mary. Martha and Mary take very different approaches to welcoming and providing hospitality to Jesus. The focus of Martha is upon preparing and serving a dinner for Jesus. In contrast, Mary spends her time listening to Jesus. Martha, in a moment of frustration, complains to Jesus about Mary and her lack of attention to providing support to the preparation of the meal. Jesus uses the remarks of Martha to reflect upon the deeper reality of his visit. The service and preparations of Martha appear to lack a spirit of joyful gratitude for the presence of Jesus at their home and table. While not condemning Martha, Jesus in referring to the "better part" highlights the reality that time spent with him can transform our lives by lifting our burdens, renewing our spirits, and freeing us from the pitfalls of seeing the meaning and value of our lives only in our productivity and activity. The time freely shared by Mary in being with Jesus is the "pearl of greatest price" and the treasured moments that lead to greater union with Jesus – Our Friend, Our Lord, Our Savior – who always lifts our burdens and shares the consolation and peace the world cannot give. We ourselves have opportunities to experience the "better part" that Jesus shared with Mary by being in his presence in Adoration and quiet prayer.

May God – Father, Son, Holy Spirit – abundantly bless your families in this upcoming week.

AN INVITATION TO ADORATION SHARING TIME WITH JESUS OUR SAVIOR PRAYING WITH THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

The story of Martha and Mary in the Gospel of Luke reminds us of the tremendous blessing of spending time and deepening our relationship to Jesus. From the very beginning of the Christian story, the Eucharist has been central. It has been called the Source and Summit of the Christian Life. Through the celebration of the Mass, we come to a deeper union with Christ, Our Lord and Savior. But our prayer with the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Blessed Sacrament does not have to be limited to the Mass. The true gift of our Church is that in the quiet of Adoration we can grow in our appreciation for Jesus and his power to reveal his love to our hearts.

As Saint Alphonsus Liguori observed, "Know also that you will probably gain more by praying fifteen minutes before the Blessed Sacrament than by all the other spiritual exercises of the day."

On each Thursday, Saint Cyril offers this gift of Adoration two times. First, Adoration is offered following Mass from 12:30PM to 1:00PM. Second, an hour of Adoration is offered from 6:00PM to 7:00PM. All are invited to receive the graces that Jesus offers to all who come to his Real Presence in Adoration.





