- (12) **Equator** an imaginary line that divides the Earth into northern and southern halves.
- (13) **Pole** a point on Earth farthest from the equator.
- (14) **Hemisphere** half of the Earth.
- (15) **Compass Rose** shows directions on a map or globe
- (16) <u>Intermediate directions</u> between the cardinal directions (southeast, northwest, northwest, southwest)
