- (1) **Location** - the place where something is.
- (2) **Landform** - a kind of land with a special shape, such as a mountain, hill, or plain.
- (3) **Region** - an area of land with the same features.
- (4) **Climate** - the kind of weather a place has over a long time.
- (5) **Cardinal directions** - the main directions of north, south, east, and west. (Never Eat Soggy Waffles)
- (6) **Relative Location** - tells what a place is near. (EX: FVCCA is near the Church)
- (7) **Absolute Location** - the exact location. (EX: 100 Jerome Ave)
- (8) **Map Grid** - a set of lines that divide a map into columns and rows of squares
- (9) **Peninsula** - land that has water on only three sides
- (10) **Island** - a landform with water all around it.
- (11) **Table** - chart that organizes information
- (12) **Equator** - an imaginary line that divides the Earth into northern and southern halves.
- (13) **Pole** - a point on Earth farthest from the equator.
- (14) **Hemisphere** - half of the Earth.
- (15) **Compass Rose** - shows directions on a map or globe
- (16) **Intermediate directions** - between the cardinal directions (southeast, northeast, northwest, southwest)
