
Math Quiz 1 - 9/18 - Place Value

- (a) Place value identification up to hundreds
 - What is the value of the highlighted digit?
 - (1) 4<u>5</u>7 Ex: 50
 - (2) 89<u>1</u>
 - (3) <u>6</u>78
 - (4) 56<u>5</u>
 - Write a 3-digit number that includes a 6 in the ones place. Ex: 716
- (b) Place value comparison
 - There is the digit, 8, in both 817 and 181, which number is bigger? Why? Ex: 817 is bigger than 181 because the digit 8 in 817 is in the hundreds place, while the digit 8 in 181 is in the tens place.
- (c) Place value standard and expanded form
 - Write 278 in expanded form. Ex: 200 + 70 + 8
 - What is the standard form of 300 + 50 + 1? Ex: 351
- (d) Place value visual models using base-10 blocks
 - Show the value of 32 by illustrating base-10 blocks. **Squares as hundreds, lines as 10s, dots as ones.
