Lesson 1: What is a Family?

- Families are groups of people who love and care for one another.
- Every family is different, but all families help and love each other.

Lesson 2: Families Change Over Time

- Families grow when new people join (babies are born, people get married).
- Families may move to new places or change jobs.

Lesson 3: Families Long Ago vs. Today

- Families long ago had fewer machines and did more work by hand.
Families today use technology (phones, cars, computers).

Lesson 4: Family Traditions

- Traditions are special things families do together (holidays, foods, celebrations).
- Families share traditions to stay connected.

Lesson 5: Family Histories

- Family history means things that happened in the past.
- Some families keep memories by stories, pictures, or letters.

Lesson 6: Timelines

- A timeline shows events in order from past to present

Lesson 7: Historical Sources

- Sources help us learn about the past.
- Examples: photographs, objects (artifacts), letters, old toys.

Lesson 8: Comparing Then and Now

- Many things change (houses, clothing, toys).
- Some things stay the same.

Lesson 9: Maps and Homes

- Homes can be in cities, suburbs, or rural areas.
- Maps help show location of places.

- Families help one another by sharing chores.
- Families make decisions together.
