From the Paston Desk

Seventh Sunday of Easter



My brothers and sisters, just a few days ago, at the Ascension, we heard the messengers asking the apostles why they were standing and looking up as Jesus ascended into the heavens. They seemed to be saying,

"There is still work to be done - look around you."

The first reading this weekend indicates how Stephen and all the apostles did just that. Full of the Holy Spirit they continued the mission Jesus began. Through our baptism, we are called to be that replenishment in our time, to look around our world and to act.

Psalm 97 reminds us also to appreciate the blessings of each day so that prayer becomes the nourishment and the strength for the commitment to act.

So, what do we see as we look around?

Do we see what Jesus and the apostles saw in their time? Do we see those in pain, grieving?

Do we see what is in danger of being destroyed – Earth, the dignity of its inhabitants?

Do we see those who have been left out, ignored, forgotten?

As we live out our baptism, the continuation of Jesus' mission, may we live in ways that God's love is truly manifest in us and through us. May God's love ease the discomfort we may feel of stepping into those different spaces so that we can joyfully share God's loving presence.
