

Divine Mercy Sunday



"Those who sincerely say 'Jesus, I trust in You' will find comfort in all their anxieties and fears. There is nothing more man needs than Divine Mercy – that love which is benevolent, which is compassionate, which raises man above his weakness to the infinite heights to the holiness of God." JPII

When St. Pope John Paul II canonized St. Faustina, he surprised the entire world by establishing Divine Mercy Sunday as a feast day for the entire Church. The feast day falls on the Second Sunday of the Easter season. On that day, John Paul II declared, "This is the happiest day of my life."

Through St. Faustina, the Merciful Savior has given the aching world new channels for the outpouring of His grace. These new channels include the Image of The Divine Mercy, the Feast of Mercy (Divine Mercy Sunday), the Divine Mercy Chaplet at 3 o'clock in the afternoon, the Hour of Great Mercy, and the Novena to The Divine Mercy.

As Jesus told St. Faustina: My Heart overflows with great mercy for souls, and especially for poor sinners. It is for them that the Blood and Water flowed from My Heart as from a fount overflowing with mercy. For them I dwell in the tabernacle as King of Mercy (Diary, 367).

Thus, I invite all of you to join us to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet and receive all Jesus's blessings, comfort, and love.

PRESCHOOL SUMMER CAMP

Pre-K Camps are available for children ages 2.9-5 yrs old. Children must be potty trained and have a current physical in order to register. Full Day Camp will run M-F from 8am -3pm and will be \$325 a week. Half Day Camp will run M-F from 8-12pm and will be \$200 a week. Extended Care hours from 3pm-5pm will be \$8.00 per hour.
