

From the Pasto

My Brothers and Sisters in Christ.



I just want to say Thank You, Thank You, Thank You for all of the many prayers and cards that I have received before and after my liver transplant on January 8th. I was home watching the Patriot's last game of the season when the phone rang and it was UMass calling to tell me

they had a liver for me and to come right away. Needless to say and not much time to think about it, I flew to the hospital.

After a twelve hour surgery and 80 staples in my abdomen, I awoke in the ICU attached to so many machines I lost count. After 10 days of intensive care and learning how to walk again and care for myself, I was discharged home. Once home, I had to keep track of the 46 pills a day I had to take, and I am now down to 25 pills a day. That goes along with the many side effects of the medication.

With all that said, the staples have been removed and I am making great progress in my recovery and hope to see you all very soon.

One thing I want to share with you is please don't ever underestimate the power of prayer. When the doctors came by my ICU room the day after my surgery, I thanked the lead doctor for obtaining my new liver. He told me, "Mr. Graves do not thank me, thank God because somehow you bypassed thousands of people on the transplant list. God has a reason."

I also learned after the surgery that I had a lesion on my old liver that was extremely rare and that there have been only six cases of this lesion recorded in the world. I believe that I am here today through the graces of all your prayers.

So needless to say you are all in my prayers. Also please remember in your prayers my donor who died so that I could be given a second chance at life and his/her family to comfort them in the loss of their loved one.

Again, thank you all and I miss you.
