



New Bishop of Norwich



His Holiness, Pope Francis, has appointed Monsignor Richard F. Reidy, JCL, presently Vicar General and Moderator of the Curia of the Diocese of Worcester, to become the sixth Bishop of Norwich, Connecticut. His ordination and installation will take place on April 29, 2025 at St. Patrick Cathedral in Norwich. The announcement

was made this morning by Cardinal Christophe Pierre, apostolic nuncio to the United States.

Bishop-elect Reidy succeeds Bishop Emeritus Michael C. Cote who retired Sept. 3, 2024 after 21 years as bishop of the Norwich diocese. Archbishop Christopher J. Coyne, Archbishop of Hartford, is currently serving as Apostolic Administrator of the diocese.

Let us pray for Monsignor Reidy and his future ministry. May the Lord Jesus make of him a good and loving shepherd and Mother Mary embrace him and his diocese with her loving arms.
