FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

"Where's the beef?" is a catchphrase in the United States and Canada. It originated as a slogan for the fast food chain Wendy's and has become an all-purpose phrase questioning the substance of an idea, event or product.

The phrase first came to public attention in a U.S. television commercial for the Wendy's chain of hamburger restaurants in 1984. The strategy behind the campaign was to distinguish competitors' big name sandwiches from Wendy's modest Single by focusing on the large bun used by the competitors vs. the larger beef patty in Wendy's sandwich. In the ad, actress Clara Peller receives a burger with a massive bun from a fictional competitor who uses the slogan "Home of the Big Bun". The small patty prompts Peller to angrily exclaim, "Where's the beef?" After the Peller ad aired, the catchphrase was repeated in television shows, films, magazines, and other media outlets.

Over the years I have had many opportunities to interview prospective employees. Before my priesthood, it was for hospital office personnel. Since then it has run the gamut of Church personnel from priests to school principals. I've even worked with search committees when seeking individuals for higher level jobs. It comes down to this: you need to do due diligence before offering a job to someone, because the person that you thought you were getting as a result of an interview may not turn out to be the employee you hoped for, perhaps prompting you to ask, "Where's the Beef?"

For example, once when seeking a school principal with the help of a search committee, we were unanimously in favor of hiring this person who seemed to be great for the job. They had everything you could possibly want and interviewed very well. To every challenge they were presented in the interview, they had done that before and could do it again. Once on the job, however, many of those things they claimed to have done were mysteriously unfamiliar to them. The fact is that some people are expert at getting a job, but not at doing it.

Jesus knew human nature better than anyone. And so when John the Baptist sent the question from prison: "Are you the one who is to come, or should we look for another?," Jesus did not answer, "Yes, it is I." Rather

His response was to invite His questioners to report what they observed instead of what they were told, as actions give better evidence of who we are than what we say we are.

As we identify ourselves as followers of the same Jesus, what we say about ourselves holds little weight if our actions do not support the claim. As Advent proceeds, may we ask for the grace to walk the walk with Jesus and not just talk the talk, lest we leave others wondering about our claims to Christianity and asking, "Where's the Beef?"

Bishop Gregory Parkes was born in Mineola, New York, on April 2, 1964. He attended St. Vincent de Paul Regional Seminary in Boynton Beach, Florida from 1993-1996 and the Pontifical North American College in the Vatican City State from 1996-2000. He holds a Sacred Theology (S.T.B.) degree from the Pontifical Gregorian University (1998) and a Canon Law (J.C.L.) degree from the Pontifical Gregorian University (2000), as well as a bachelor's degree in finance from Florida State University. He was ordained a priest of the Orlando diocese by Bishop Norbert Dorsey on June 26, 1999. Assignments after ordination included: parochial vicar, Holy Family Catholic Church, Orlando from 2000-2004 and parochial administrator and pastor of Corpus Christi Catholic Church, Celebration, Florida, from 2005-2012. Bishop Parkes also served the Orlando diocese as Vicar General and Chancellor for Canonical Affairs and as the pastor of Corpus Christi Parish in Celebration, Florida. On March 20, 2012, Pope Benedict XVI appointed him Bishop of Pensacola-Tallahassee. He was installed as the fifth bishop of Pensacola-Tallahassee on June 5, 2012. Bishop Robert N. Lynch, 75, was ordained to the priesthood for the Archdiocese of Miami on May 13, 1978. He was appointed the fourth bishop of St. Petersburg on December 5, 1995, and was installed on January 26, 1996. The diocese of St. Petersburg comprises 3,177 square miles in the state of Florida. It has a total population of 3,009,840 people of whom 445,456, or 14 percent, are Catholic.

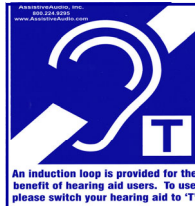
