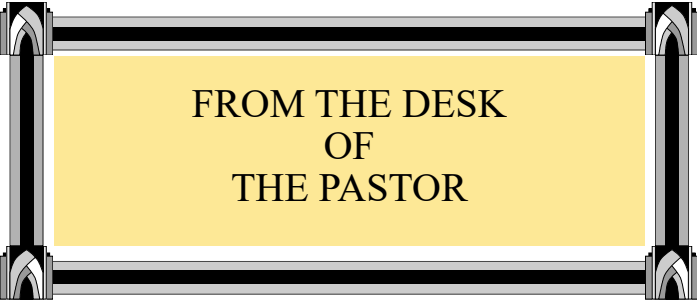

FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ:

Epiphany celebrates the manifestation of God who is invisible, made visible in human nature in the person of Jesus Christ. What has captured the imagination of people through the centuries is the journey of the Magi from the East whom we refer to as the three wise men or kings. The gospel does not tell us there were three, but the number was deduced from the three gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh.

The practice of giving gifts at this time seems to have stemmed from the Magi actions; leading up to Christmas and during this season we do the same. Some gifts are practical and some are fun. Children especially prefer the fun ones. But the most important thing is the thought that went into the gift and the relationship between giver and receiver; that is what gives it meaning.

The American author, O. Henry, wrote a short story which he called "The Gift of the Magi." It tells of a young married couple, Della and Jim, who were very poor but deeply in love. Della's greatest pride was her long beautiful dark hair. Her husband knew she wanted a set of decorative combs to wear in her hair, and despite their poverty, he was determined to get them for her. Jim's greatest treasure was the gold pocket watch which had belonged first to his grandfather and then to his father. His wife saw a platinum watch chain which she thought would be perfect for his timepiece, and despite their poverty, she was determined to get it for him.

Christmas Eve came and he had the combs for her. She had the watch chain for him. But when they went to exchange gifts, they discovered that she had cut and sold her hair to buy the watch chain for him and he had sold the watch to buy the combs for her. After their shock, they cried a bit and then laughed and fell into each other's arms. They realized that the combs and the watch chain mean nothing. It is the love they represent that counts.

Epiphany is also the traditional day in our Church for the blessing of home and family. The ritual doesn't require a priest and I encourage each of you to do the simple blessing that follows as you return to your homes with your families today.

Upon entering the house, all make the sign of the cross. The leader begins:

Peace be with this house and all who live here.

The following Scripture is read: (John 1:14):

And the word became flesh and made His dwelling among us, and we saw His glory, the glory as of the Father's only Son, full of grace and truth.

The leader then says the blessing:

Lord God of heaven and earth, You revealed Your only begotten Son to every nation by the guidance of a star. Bless our home and all who live here. Fill us with the light of Christ, that our concern for others may reflect Your love. We ask this through Christ our Lord.

All make the sign of the cross while saying:

May the Lord bless us, protect us from all evil and bring us to everlasting life...Amen

2017 WINTER CONCERT SERIES**Sunday, Jan. 8, 2017, at 3:00 pm**

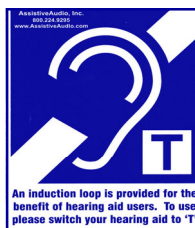
