FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

The southern part of Greece is almost an island except for a little neck of land attaching it to the northern part. On this little neck, in ancient Greece, was the city of Corinth. Because of its location, people traveling from the North to the South by land had to pass through Corinth. Even those traveling by sea often dragged their boat across the narrow strip of land rather than risk the nautically dangerous cape at the southern tip of the country. Some have referred to Corinth as the Vanity Fair of the ancient world as it was the place where one could meet almost anyone and everyone if you stayed long enough. To add to the popularity of the place, Corinth was where the Isthmian Games were held, which were second only to the Olympics. It was a wealthy and populous city with one of the greatest commercial trades in the ancient world.

Corinth had a dark side which made it into a byword for sleazy living. In some ways it had the reputation in the ancient world that Las Vegas (Sin City) does in our times. In the Greek language, the verb *korinthiazesthai*, meaning to live like a Corinthian, means to live in drunkenness and debauchery. In 17th century England, the word even made it into the English language, where calling someone a Corinthian meant they were known for drunken and reckless living.

Surprisingly, St. Paul had great success in Corinth. In fact, he had more success in preaching there than in Athens, and stayed in Corinth longer than in any other place in which he started a Christian community. Later, when he heard of problems arising in the church there after he had left, he wrote to the community in Corinth in an effort to set it back on track to Christ.

This weekend, we read from the first part of Paul's first letter to the Corinthians. Later in his letter, St. Paul dealt with numerous issues of Christian living that are still instructive for us in the Church today. His writings help us to live in imitation of Christ and not as the Corinthians of the ancient world did.

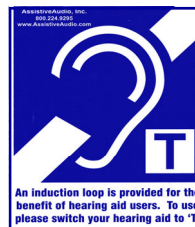
