

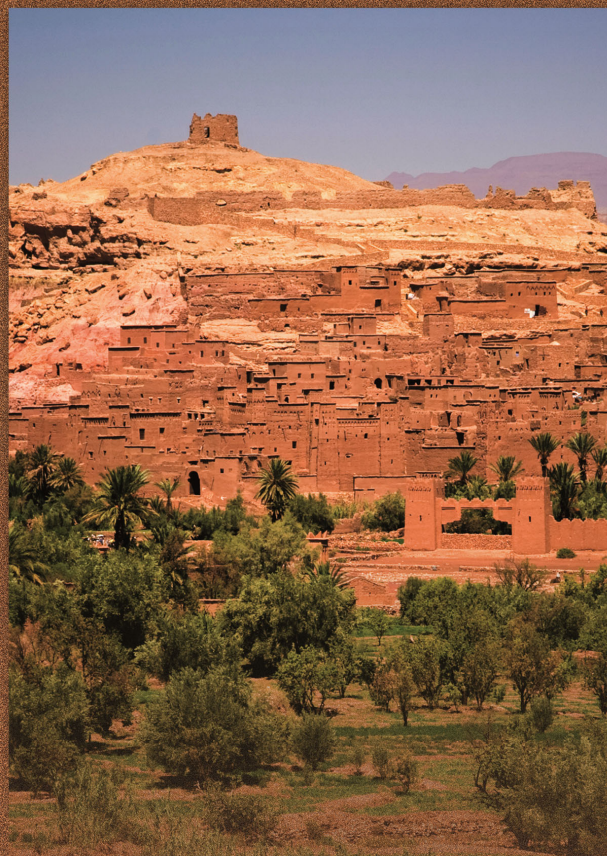

FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

In Saint Paul's Letter to the Romans, he reminds us, "For you did not receive a spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you received a Spirit of adoption, through whom we cry, 'Abba, Father.'" The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs, heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if only we suffer with Him so that we may also be glorified with Him."

St. Paul is saying how completely we have been invited to be part of the family of God. Like those adoptive parents who, upon taking a child into their homes, love them as their own, so God loves us as He loves His own Son, Jesus.

Therefore, the question is not whether God accepts us as part of His family, but whether we accept being fully part of God's family. Many parents, adoptive or

otherwise, lament that their older children begin to withdraw from family activities and only come home to sleep and eat. Home has become for them no longer the center of family life, but merely like an apartment from which they can come and go.

We can get into a similar mindset, treating God, our "Abba, Father", who wants to share our life, as someone we stop by to see only when we feel the need, not realizing how His love for us makes Him ache for our presence.

Will we accept both the joys and the hardships that this family endures? Will we be part of this family's gatherings (Mass) or have we removed ourselves from active participation in the life of God's family? Do we support the family by the witness of our lives and by the sharing of our time, talent and treasure?

All relationships are two-way streets. Having been invited to be "joint heirs with Christ," we know that God will keep up His end of the relationship. May we recommit ourselves to keeping up our part.

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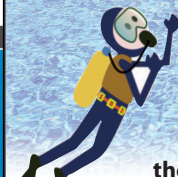
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
