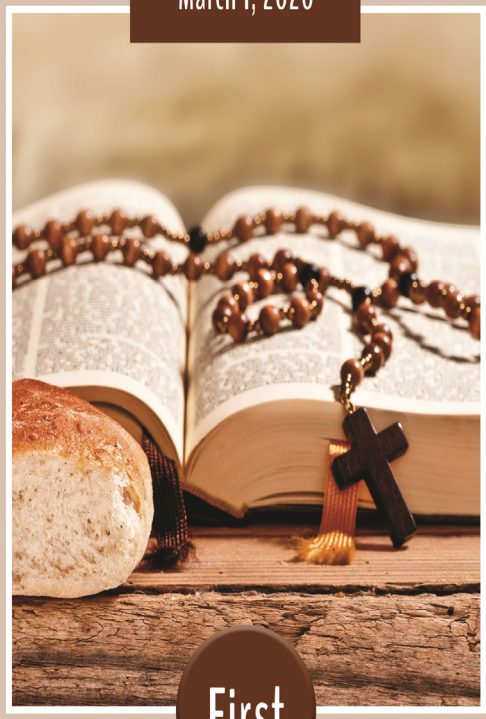

A deepening of our spiritual lives requires a radical expansion of the heart in order to be authentic. It entails replacing the heart of stone with a heart of flesh (Ezekiel 36:26). This, in turn, opens our hearts inward to receive the love of Christ and outward in order to love those whom Christ loves.

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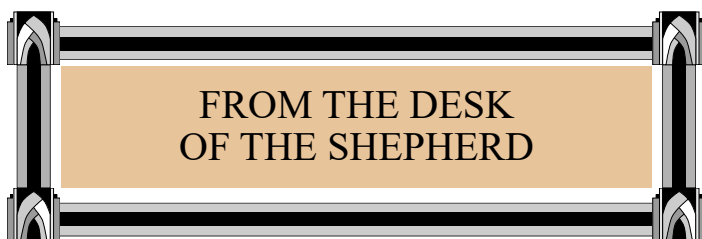
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#### **Eucharistic Exposition and Benediction**

Every Wednesday, in the Oratory, parishioners have the opportunity to pray before the exposed Blessed Sacrament. Exposition begins immediately after the 8 a.m. Mass and concludes with Benediction at 6:45 p.m. A Holy Hour for vocations that includes prayers, the rosary and a litany is prayed aloud in English from 6-6:45 p.m. and again in Spanish from 7-8 p.m.

### **Lead Us Not Into Temptation**

This weekend is the first Sunday of Lent, the time of the Church year when all Christians are called to personal sacrifice for ourselves and others, time to reflect and to pray. This theme is reflected in this weekend's Gospel from St Matthew when we read about Jesus facing temptations while in the wilderness. These 40 days and nights that Jesus endured show us the humanity of our Lord as He faced hunger and hardship, just as we might imagine we would as well.

When a person is down, struggling or hungry, they might be tempted to do things that they wouldn't normally do. They might compromise their values, beliefs or take a shortcut. Many, if not all of us, have been in difficult situations and may have been tempted to compromise. The Bible tells us Jesus was tempted three times. But to get what the devil promised, He would have to compromise. He would have to give up what He believed for short-term comfort.

Take time this Lent to reflect on what tempts you and what you compromise for personal gain or pleasure. Many times, what you gain by caving in to temptation has a negative impact on others, either directly, or indirectly through our example. When you pray the Lord's Prayer today, focus on the words, "Lead *me* not into temptation but deliver *me* from evil," and meditate upon these words during this Lenten season.

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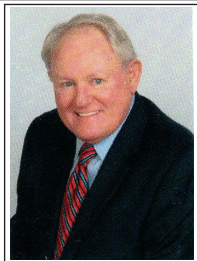
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
