



Dear Friends in Christ,



I can remember my first assignment change as a young priest just two years ordained at the age of thirty adjusting from the Sponge docks of Tarpon Springs to the cow pastures of Valrico. I had arrived at St. Stephen's in July of 1993 and discovered that it was a bedroom community of Tampa. I vividly remember a young military mom asking me how my adjustment was going, and I said fine. She looked at me with empathy and said, "Father, I am used to moving every two or three years with the military but at least I can bring my family with me. For you as a priest you have to adjust to (or even create)

a whole new family." At that time in my life, it was what I needed to hear. I was convinced that the Episcopal motto (Deus Providebit – God Provides) of the bishop who ordained me was true not just for Bishop Favalora but for all of us.

Last weekend, I used this column to let you know that there will be a significant change in the office as Ozzie Quevedo will be leaving us at the end of this week. I am thrilled to announce that beginning March 3rd, Carmen Hilmes will be taking over the role of parish Office Manager. She has most recently been serving as the executive assistant to the VP of Mission Advancement for EWTN in Birmingham, AL. She also has experience in managing parishes in Washington state and on military bases in Germany. Once I saw that she was the Executive Secretary for Bishop Lynch from January 2012 thru December 2015 I knew that I had to give her an interview, even though I had thought that we were finished interviewing at that point. As most of you know, Dcn. Paul retired from his day job here in the office, even though he will still be with us in his role with diaconate ministry on the weekends and for about 10 hours of volunteer service each week once he returns from his sabbatical. To help close the gap, I am bringing Mike Manion onto the staff as my Pastoral Assistant in a part-time role beginning March 3rd. He already serves the parish as a volunteer with the choir and training the altar servers. Additionally, our long-time sacristan Tracy Marshall asked me over a year ago if she could retire due to her increased need of caring for her aging parents. We have finally been able to find someone to step up and take the role of Head Sacristan. Maria Acuria will begin her time on the staff on March 3rd as well but Tracy will stay in place for training purposes until after Easter.


