





Pastor's Column



Dear Friends in Christ.

This is the weekend of Corpus Christi. The joy of the pilgrimages that I offer every year is sometimes enhanced by trips to museum exhibits. The problem is that we often must rush through the exhibit and don't have the time to take it all in during our visit. When my classmate at Christ the King in Tampa made the historical exhibit of Eucharistic Miracles available to other parishes, I was the first one to reach out to him. At this writing we don't yet have the display but by the time you are reading this it will be up in

the back of the church, known as D-hall. The exhibit features over 50, 2' x 5' detailed vinyl panels, for both welcoming visitors and content highlighting some of the most powerful Eucharistic Miracles of the World. The panels were selected from 126 recognized accounts that date from as early as the third century.

The exhibit's purpose is to increase awareness of the Real Presence of our LORD in the Eucharist and promote Eucharistic Adoration. This Vatican-approved international exhibit was designed and created by Blessed Carlo Acutis. His canonization has been rescheduled by Pope Leo XIV for Sunday, September 7th, 2025. An artist, cartoonist, and avid computer enthusiast, Acutis created the art for the panels before his death from leukemia at age 15 in 2006. He was the first millennial to be beatified on October 10th, 2020, just one step away from sainthood. When I planned the itinerary for our Italy pilgrimage in November of 2023, I made sure that Lanciano, the famed site of one of the oldest Eucharistic Miracles, was included on the tour. We also got a chance to visit Blessed Carlo Acutis' grave when we were in Assisi. I'm thrilled that we have this exhibit again this weekend. This will be the third year in a row that we've been able to acquire this travelling exhibit on this great Feast of Corpus Christi. Please do yourself a favor and visit the D-Hall at your convenience some time this weekend and wander through the exhibit. Invite friends and neighbors that may not have had the opportunity to see the exhibit before this weekend. Making time for investigating extraordinary instances of Eucharistic Miracles is not however as important as making time for the LORD.

We'll be offering that time with a Holy Hour following the 11am Mass this Sunday immediately following the Eucharistic Procession in our parking lot. Remember your obligation is to celebrate the Eucharist by taking part in the Mass. This wonderful opportunity that we have this weekend is an additional blessing for this great Solemnity of Corpus Christi. Next weekend we'll be celebrating another Solemnity honoring Saints Peter and Paul. As it's the final weekend of June, it will also be the final weekend for Fr. Ted Costello on his official assignment, here at St. Michael the Archangel. Sunday, June 29th at the 11am Mass is his final Mass.


