


We celebrate the 14<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time in the liturgical cycle this weekend, but it lands on the first weekend in July which is significant for us on a number of levels. As a holiday weekend we may have some visitors in our midst while many of our regular worshippers will probably be out of town. As the beginning of the new fiscal year, it is the time when new priestly assignments begin and changes in clergy take place in parishes throughout the diocese. While we have already bid farewell to Fr. Ted Costello, I don't at this writing have confirmation of when Fr. Emmanuel Ofori will have clearance to make

his travel plans to depart from his home country of Ghana to serve us here at St. Michael the Archangel. I have spoken to him twice on the phone now and have been highly impressed. He is very excited to be coming to us and the experience of 27 years as a priest in his own Archdiocese of Kumasi will undoubtedly be a blessing to us in ways that we cannot now foresee with clarity. I don't have his name on the Mass schedule until after my two-week vacation which concludes on August 9<sup>th</sup>. That is just a precautionary measure, and you can be sure that I am very grateful for the commitments made by both Fr. John D'Antonio and Fr. Eric Peters to help during the next six weeks. Please pray that Fr. Emmanuel will be able to get his visa in order so that his travel arrangements can be made soon. I have been told that travel visa delays are normal, especially in our current political environment.

While the month of July may seem like a slow one as many people are away on vacation, there are still things happening at the parish of which you should be made aware. For example, next weekend, we will be having a visitor to speak at all of the liturgies as it is the annual mission cooperative appeal. We receive the annual MCA from the Diocesan Office of the Propagation of the Faith. This year our assigned missionary is a Mother Superior. Sister Mary Wandia of the Adorer Missionary Sisters of the Poor will be coming to us from Kenya to speak to us about the mission that her community provides to those impoverished in that developing part of the world. Please come next weekend ready to give generously to a second collection that will not stay in the parish but be sent to the poorest of the poor. I don't want to spoil what comes later in the month but given the heat, how does Christmas in July sound? Stay tuned.


## PRAYER TO OUR PATRON SAINT
