

# **Pastor's Column**



Dear Friends in Christ,

08/17/2025

We live in a world where families are divided due to strong feelings about politics and religion. This is really nothing new. It just is at a fever pitch in recent days. In the gospel this weekend Jesus predicts that families will be divided three against two and two against three. When I was at my cousin Fr. Ken Hallahan's 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Priesthood Ordination celebration in New Jersey two weeks ago, he was nervous about two family members present. One of them had strong left leaning passions and the other was a heavy

duty Maga supporter. Thankfully, problems were averted when the parties didn't sit anywhere near each other.

One week from Tuesday is the birthday of one of my closest friends who happens to be a pastor just up the road, settling into his new assignment. That is also the day (August 26<sup>th</sup>) that our New Associate Pastor, Fr. Emmanuel Ofori, has an expedited appointment with the U.S. Embassy in his home country of Ghana to take care of the visa issue that has been the cause of his delay in arriving for his assignment here at St. Michael the Archangel. When I know more about how that appointment went and if he was able to get the green light on making his travel plans to join us, I will be certain to let you know. This week is when our new Youth Minister, Nathan Gonzalez, will begin his new ministry with our parish. The fire that our LORD wishes were ablaze on the earth was seen in Rome at the Jubilee Year of Hope's celebration of Youth and Young Adults a couple of weeks ago. I understand that Nathan was present for that celebration, and I'm quite eager to meet with him this week to see how we can work as a team to attract more young people to our Youth Ministry here at St. Michael the Archangel Parish. As our faith formation and youth ministry programs get going for this year it's an exciting time of renewal. Pray that our young families will be engaged in the process and be convinced that investing in their Spiritual lives is worth the time and effort.
