



Pastor's Column



Dear Friends in Christ,

08/24/2025

In today's gospel passage, Jesus encourages His Disciples to "Strive to enter through the narrow gate, for many, I tell you, will attempt to enter but will not be strong enough" (Lk 13:24). Hearing these words at this time of year reminds me that our OCIA, formerly known as the RCIA, process is getting started very soon. The Church year operates on a calendar that is somewhat similar to the school year calendar, as far as the programs are concerned and the OCIA is no different. It's truly a blessing to welcome those who have

journeyed through some challenging pathways to make it through the narrow gate, that is the entrance into the Catholic Church as an adult. So many people have canonical issues regarding prior bonds of marriage and are not free to enter before a formal annulment case can be completed. Such delays in the process turn some away but others respond with greater resolve to strengthen their bond with God and the Church. I personally tend to take the path of least resistance, but I sure do admire those who have been through the gauntlet and have battled to become and remain Catholic in the face of very challenging circumstances. If you know someone who has been searching for a deeper relationship with God in the Catholic Church, please introduce him or her to our inquiry sessions of the OCIA beginning Tuesday, September 2nd, 2025 at 6:45pm in room 13 (Parish Library).

As I mentioned in this column last weekend, Fr. Emmanuel should be meeting with the American Embassy in his home country of Ghana this Tuesday, to resolve the issue of his work visa that has been the cause of the delay of his arrival here at our parish for his assignment as our new Parochial Vicar. Please keep him and the whole situation in your prayers. On Wednesday, our Music Director, Francesco Sclafani, will be meeting with the first group of children who have signed up to take part in a children's choir. This will be the final Wednesday that our Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament will take place in the Oratory, also known as the Blessed Sacrament Chapel. Beginning next Wednesday, September 3rd, Adoration and Benediction will take place in the Church unless otherwise noted (ex. Ash Wednesday).




We are half way through the year of 2025 with the CMA Goal. Right now we have 76.3% of Goal Pledged and 71% of Goal Paid.
