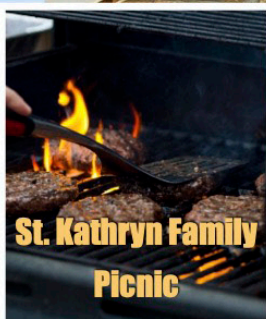

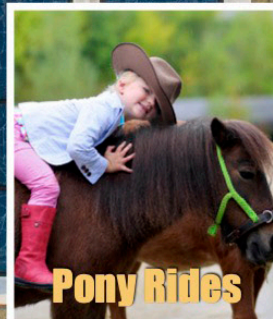

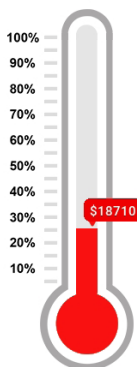

RELIGIOUS ED REGISTRATION

Religious education registration forms for grades 1-8 for school year 2023-2024 are available online at <https://www.stkathryns.org/religious-educationgrades-1-8> and in the back of the church. We are now in the late registration phase, so the registration fee has increased to \$65/child and \$110/family, as late registration allows us less time for planning and obtaining materials. Please register by August 1st to avoid the next fee increase. First Penance takes place in second grade. Confirmation and First Communion take place in third grade with a \$25 sacramental fee. All parents are encouraged to sign their children up for religious education, regardless of whether or not it is a sacrament year for them. How important it is to build that foundation of faith! We have two religious ed groups, and they meet on alternating weeks. Please send in your registrations as soon as possible for the best chance to select the group that is most convenient to your schedule.

YOUTH CAMP



Saint Kathryn Parish is hosting a youth camp from August 6-9, 2023. After morning Mass the children, grades 8-12, with adult supervision and assistance, will be doing work in the local community. Work will include yard work and cleanup, painting both indoors and out, and minor carpentry repairs. A team leader will make an appointment to survey the site to ensure we have all necessary tools and supplies. There is no cost to the homeowner for the work.

BAZAAR CRAFT DONATIONS

One of the most eagerly anticipated parts of our Annual Christmas Bazaar and Penny Sale every November is the amazing array of crafts for sale. If you love to craft, please consider donating a craft or two (or ten?) for our craft area this year. (Also, consider joining our Crafting Team on Tuesdays from noon-4:00!) Any newly created craft *no more than a few months old* is appreciated: knitted or crocheted items, home décor, Christmas crafts, ornaments, jewelry, paintings, hand-poured candles, handmade games for kids, pottery, soaps, trending crafts from YouTube or Pinterest--whatever gets your creative juices flowing! Please drop donated crafts off to the Parish Office during our business hours any time of year for storage in the craft room until the Bazaar in November. (Please note we can only accept craft donations at this time, not Penny Sale or Theme Basket donations due to limited space.) *Donated crafts become the property of the parish and all tagging and pricing decisions will be made by the Crafting Team.* The team may display a donated craft in a different area of the Bazaar if deemed a better placement (Penny Sale, Basket Room, etc.); donate the item elsewhere at their discretion; and, store or donate items that may be left over after the Bazaar.

KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS

Following the carnage of the Civil War, the American Red Cross was founded in 1881, by Clara Barton, as a means of assisting wounded soldiers. Since that time, it has continually provided blood services, disaster relief, and medical training. The Red Cross still provides more than 40% of the blood supply and products in the country. Every 2 seconds, someone in the US needs blood or platelets. About 29,000 units of blood are needed every day. Just one donation can save up to three lives.

The Knights of Columbus were donating blood to local hospitals prior to the Red Cross implementing their blood donor services. The Knights of Columbus has teamed up with the Red Cross from the start of the program assisting with blood drives. Council 5162 will be hosting a Red Cross blood drive on June 10th from 9 am to 2 pm in the parish hall. It is suggested that you make an appointment for the event, walk-ins are welcome, but there may be an extended wait time.

Marguerite D'Youville Parish in Groveton, NH; Hudson Community Food Pantry; St. Gianna's Place; and to Catholic School Education in our Diocese.

MEDICAL SUPPLY DRIVE FOR VALLEY OF THE ANGELS SCHOOL

Friends of the parish, Kealin and Ryan McManus, will be going on a mission trip to Valley of the Angels School in Guatemala this summer to assist with teaching the students prayers in English and to provide some much needed maintenance on the buildings and grounds. In years past, we have done backpack drives for Valley of the Angels. This year, they are requesting medical supplies to help stock their school clinic. The children live at the school ten months out of the year, which adds up to a lot of medical supplies! Here is the wish list from the school nurse: *face masks for adults, face masks for kids, disposable gowns, disposable gloves, Neosporin, Fluconazole (nail fungus treatment), pediatric acetaminophen, pediatric Tylenol, Nexium, allergy medicine, Reactine, Polysporin, pediatric vitamins, Eucerin cream, antidiarrheal medicine, pediatric Benadryl, cough medicine, stethoscope, Ibuprofen, Band-aids, Thomas neck for kids and adults, arm and leg support (immobilizers), pediatric and adult sphygmomanometer, elastic bandages of 2, 3, 4, and 6 inches, pulse oximeter, light forehead thermometer, ear thermometer, oral thermometer, gauzes, toothbrushes, toothpaste, dental floss.* Donations may be dropped off in the bin in the church vestibule during the whole month of June. If you would like to make a check donation to help offset the cost of the power washer and other cleaning items and for shipping the medical supplies, please make it out to Saint Kathryn Church with "Guatemala" in the memo field. Your prayers for safety are appreciated!
