Cursillo / Ultreya Meetings

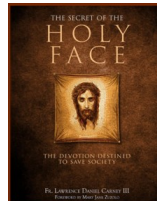
May 30th, 7:00 - 8:30 pm

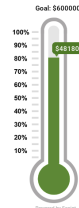

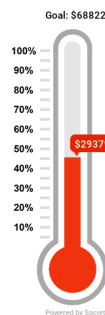
