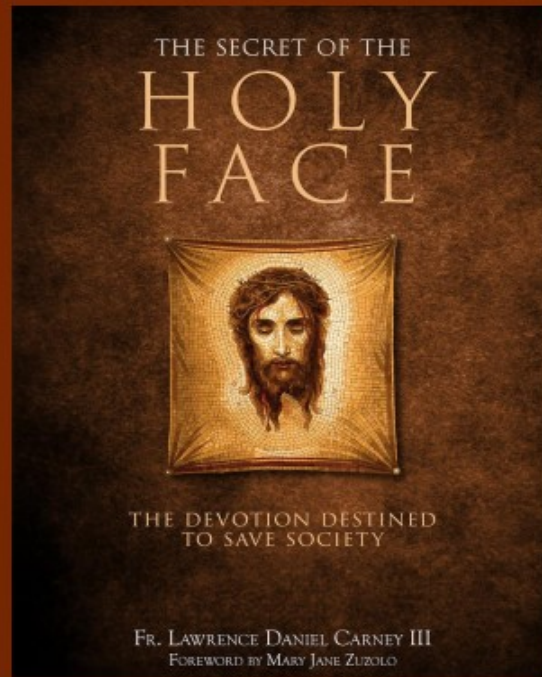

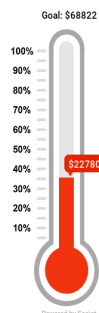
### **New Hampshire Catholic Appeal: Future of our Faith II**
