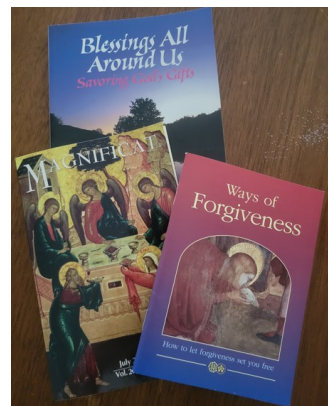
St. Kathryn's Parish Library is OPEN!

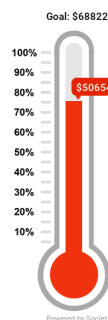
New Hampshire Catholic Appeal: Future of our Faith II
