### Centers:

Art: Students will paint using bells. We will explore our sense of hearing by rolling bells on our paper and creating artwork.

Writing and Language: Students will explore sign language. We will be working to spell our own names using sign language and to learn some common words.

Dramatic Play: Students will explore our Pre-K Cafe. We will be continuing the transformation of our Dramatic play area into a restaurant.. We will focus on how we use our sense of hearing when cooking such as listening for smoke alarms and timers.

Science: Students will investigate closed containers filled with a variety of times. They will use their sense of hearing in order to find a match for each container by finding two that makes the same sound. They will also try to guess what items are inside of each jar.

Art/Music: Students will create their own tambourines and will be able to use them during our Music and Movement time. We can't wait to add some new sounds to our classroom.
