

LOYOLAPRESS.

The story of Jesus in the home of Martha and Mary complements the story of the Good Samaritan, which immediately precedes it in Luke's Gospel. Both stories are unique to Luke. The story of the Samaritan opens with the words "a certain man." Today's reading opens with the words "a certain woman." The Samaritan is an example of how a disciple should see and act. Mary is an example of how a disciple should listen. Mary, a woman, is a marginalized person in society, like the Samaritan. Both do what is not expected of them. As a woman, Mary would be expected, like Martha, to prepare hospitality for a guest. Here again Jesus breaks with the social conventions of his time. Just as a Samaritan would not be a model for neighborliness, so a woman would not sit with the men around the feet of a teacher.

Both stories exemplify how a disciple is to fulfill the dual command which begins chapter 10—love of God (Mary) and love of neighbor (the Samaritan). These are the two essentials of life in the kingdom. By using the examples of a Samaritan and a woman, however, Jesus is saying something more. Social codes and boundaries were strict in Jesus' time. Yet to love God with all one's heart and one's neighbor requires breaking those rules. The Kingdom of God is a society without distinctions and boundaries between its members. It is a society that requires times for seeing and doing and also times for listening and learning at the feet of a teacher.

Przypowieść o Jezusie w domu Marty i Marii uzupełnia przypowieść Dobrego Samarytanina, która bezpośrednio ją poprzedza w Ewangelii Św. Łukasza. Obie są wyjątkowe tylko w Ewangelii Św. Łukasza. Historia Samarytanina rozpoczyna się słowami "pewien człowiek." Dzisiejsze czytanie rozpoczyna się słowami "pewna kobieta." Samarytanin jest przykładem tego, jak uczeń powinien widzieć i działać. Maryja jest przykładem tego, jak uczeń powinien słuchać. Maryja, kobieta, jest osobą marginalizowaną w społeczeństwie, podobnie jak Samarytanin. Oboje robią to, czego się od nich nie oczekuje. Od Marii jako kobiety oczekuje się, podobnie jak od Marty, że przygotuje gościnę dla gościa. Tutaj również Jezus zrywa z konwencjami społecznymi swoich czasów. Tak jak Samarytanin nie byłby wzorem dobrego sąsiada, tak kobieta nie usiadłaby z mężczyznami wokół stóp nauczyciela.

Obie historie pokazują, w jaki sposób uczeń ma wypełniać podwójne przykazanie, które rozpoczyna rozdział 10 - miłość Boga (Maria) i miłość bliźniego (Samarytanin). Są to dwa podstawowe elementy życia w królestwie. Posługując się przykładami Samarytanina i kobiety, Jezus mówi jednak coś więcej. Kody społeczne i granice były surowe w czasach Jezusa. Jednak miłowanie Boga z całego serca i bliźniego wymaga złamania tych zasad. Królestwo Boże to społeczeństwo bez rozróżnień i granic między jego członkami. Jest to społeczeństwo, które wymaga czasu na widzenie i działanie, a także czasu na słuchanie i uczenie się u stóp nauczyciela.



What is Alpha?

Alpha is a series of sessions exploring the Christian faith, typically run over eleven weeks. Each talk looks at a different question around faith and is designed to create conversation. Alpha is run all around the world, and everyone is welcome.

What's happening with Alpha at SS. Thomas Becket and Alphonsus Liguori Parish?

In mid-May our first Alpha course began as the start of our Alpha experience here. A group of Parish Staff members, Unification Team members, and Ministry Leaders engaged in a project of both learning



how Alpha works and experiencing the Alpha content. Each Wednesday evening we gather to share dinner together, watch a video that explores a question of faith, followed by table conversation. We sit at a table with the same people every week. So far it's been a wonderful experience of connection, curiosity, joy, discovery, and peace...and good food!

What's next for Alpha in our parish?

Our second Alpha course will start in September. This Alpha will be open to anyone who would like to give Alpha a try. Alpha provides the opportunity to: 1) Connect with new people, 2) watch an episode on a question of faith, 3) share your thoughts in a non-judgmental environment and hear from others. Consider it.

Hi! My name is Riddhima, and I am the Bulletin News Girl Leader for our Parish **American Heritage Girls Troop IL1317**. This will be my final newsletter for this program year.

Since January, **our Troop girls** have earned 183 badges, 87 patches and **completed 1,875 service hours!** Each year, girls are required to complete a minimum amount of service hours based on their age. This year, some girls have gone beyond the number of hours, and earned the **Presidential Volunteer Service Award**. According to their age level, they can earn either Bronze, Silver, or Gold. This year three girls earned Bronze, one girl earned Silver, and one girl earned Gold.

This year, one girl, **Sofiia Fomina**, **earned her Stars and Stripes award**. It is the highest award that an AHG can earn as a high school girl, and she must complete a large-scale service project. The project helps girls grow in the skills of leadership, project and time management, communication, and organization. These skills, which are cultivated in our Troop, will be essential for the girls throughout their lives. **Sofiia chose to refurbish Burke Hall for her project.** She was in charge of planning, leading, and implementing and raised funds by having a bake sale after Mass on several weekends.

Sofiia led Troop girls and adults in cleaning Burke Hall, making curtains for the windows, replacing knobs, stuffing and sewing pillows, building small tables from a kit, setting up a prayer corner, purchasing new couches and replacing ceiling tiles.

Over the course of this year, some girls earned their **AHG Catholic Faith Award** segment patches and medals. For each of the Program Levels, the AHG National Catholic committee created workbooks for Catholic girls to learn more about their faith and develop a stronger relationship with Christ. Medals earned included: God & Family, God & Country, God & Community, Woman of Integrity Moral Compass, and Woman of Integrity Quiver of Arrows.


