Witamy ponownie po wakacyjnej przerwie!

Drodzy parafianie i przyjaciele parafii Świętych Tomasza Becketa i Alfonsa Liguori,

Wraz z końcem lata i ponownym spotkaniem się w nowym sezonie dziękujemy Bogu za dar wspólnoty i dar siebie nawzajem. Święto Pracy przypomina nam nie tylko o godności pracy, ale także o znaczeniu wspólnej pracy jako jedna rodzina wiernych.

W okresie letnim wielu z nas podróżowało, odpoczywało i spędzało czas z rodziną i przyjaciółmi. Teraz, gdy powracamy do rytmu życia parafialnego, jesteśmy zaproszeni do ponownego zaangażowania się w budowanie naszej wspólnoty parafialnej. Parafia Świętych Tomasza Becketa i Alfonsa Liguori jest obdarowana wieloma darami – naszymi liturgiami, posługami, wolontariuszami i niezliczonymi sposobami w jakie dzielicie się swoim czasem, talentami i skarbami.

W tym roku stoiemy również przed nową rzeczywistością: brakiem szkoły katolickiej u Św. Alfonsa. Chociaż zmiana ta porusza wiele serc, nie możemy zapominać, że formacja wiary naszych młodych ludzi trwa nadal z siłą i nadzieję. Nasz program edukacji religijnej jest niezwykle ważny, ale jeszcze ważniejsze jest świadectwo rodziców, którzy przyprowadzają swoje dzieci na Mszę Św. i dają dobry przykład żywej wiary w domu. Rodzina pozostaje „domowym kościołem”, gdzie miłość, modlitwa i codzienne świadectwo zasiewają ziarna wiary, które rosną przez całe życie.

Święto Pracy celebuje wartość wkładu każdej osoby. Podobnie nasza parafia rozwija się gdy każdy z nas wnosi swoje wyjątkowe dary i łączy je z dziełem Chrystusa. Niezależnie od tego, czy pełnisz funkcję lektora, marszałka, członka chóru, katechety, duszpasterza czy też działasz w jednej z wielu innych służb, Twoja rola jest absolutnie niezbędna. Nawet jeśli Twoja praca polega na cichej modlitwie w ławce kościelnej, wzmacnia ona całe Ciało Chrystusa.

W tym przełomowym momencie nowego sezonu musimy również zadać sobie pytanie: co powinniśmy zrobić, aby jako jedna parafia stawić czoła przyszłości? Odpowiedź leży w pogłębianiu naszej jedności, umacnianiu naszej wiary i odnawianiu naszego zobowiązania do wspólnego podążania drogą – zawsze pamiętając, że nie jesteśmy dwiema parafiami, ale jedną parafią, jedną rodziną, jednym Ciałem Chrystusa.

Aby wzmacnić jedność naszej parafii, serdecznie zapraszamy wszystkich po każdej Mszy Św. na lekki poczęstunek i spotkanie towarzyskie z innymi parafianami.

Niech Pan błogosławi naszą pracę, uświeca nasze wysiłki i prowadzi nas swoim Duchem, gdy wspólnie wkraczamy w przyszłość.

This Week's Gospel: Luke 14:25-33

Great crowds were traveling with Jesus, and he turned and addressed them, “If anyone comes to me without hating his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple. Whoever does not carry his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple. Which of you wishing to construct a tower does not first sit down and calculate the cost to see if there is enough for its completion? Otherwise, after laying the foundation and finding himself unable to finish the work the onlookers should laugh at him and say, ‘This one began to build but did not have the resources to finish.’ Or what king marching into battle would not first sit down and decide whether with ten thousand troops he can successfully oppose another king advancing upon him with twenty thousand troops? But if not, while he is still far away, he will send a delegation to ask for peace terms. In the same way, anyone of you who does not renounce all his possessions cannot be my disciple.”


A Bishop Barron / Word on Fire Bible Study




