Dear Parishioners and Friends of Saints Thomas Becket and Alphonsus Liguori Parish,

Continuing from my last letter last month, we must keep asking ourselves **what we should do to face the future of our one parish?** It is so vital that we continue to deepen our unity, strengthen our faith, renew our commitment to walk together as one parish.

To foster our unity and address our needs, we have begun by offering **hospitality** after each Mass, providing an opportunity for us to greet one another informally. Please join us in October.

To continue, at the end of September, Cathy Walz, Director of Pastoral Ministry for the Archdiocese, facilitated a Listening Session for our staff. She is now assisting us in preparing to have Listening Sessions with all of you. These sessions will be focused on giving any of us who are challenged by the unification of St. Thomas Becket and St. Alphonsus Liguori a time to **express those challenges, needs, thoughts, and concerns**. There will be a morning session and an evening session. The dates are yet to be determined but most likely the first week of November.

In addition to these sessions, we will be conducting a **needs assessment** addressed to all parishioners. We will be asking your views on Sacramental and Spiritual Life, Faith Formation and Education, Parish Life and Community, Outreach Service, Parish Communication and Stewardship, plus an open section. This assessment will take place in early November. Following these activities, we will report all the results back to the Parish.

Then we will form our new **Parish Council** to work with me, the pastor, around what you have all shared, so we can determine priorities and unified actions that will build on our shared wisdom and faith. We request and need your participation as we continue our work as one parish.

In the meantime, I pray for our parish and its future as I journey on a pilgrimage to Fatima, Santiago de Compostela, Lourdes, Montserrat, and Barcelona with a group of parishioners. Pray the Rosary as our Mother Mary asked us, especially during the month of October.

Drodzy Parafianie i Przyjaciele parafii Świętych Tomasza Becketa i Alfonsa Liguori,

Kontynuując mój ostatni list z zeszłego miesiąca, musimy nieustannie zadawać sobie pytanie, **co powinniśmy robić, aby stawiać czoła przyszłości naszej nowej parafii?** Bardzo ważne jest, abyśmy nadal pogłębiali naszą jedność, umacniali naszą wiarę i odnawiali nasze zobowiązanie do wspólnego kroczenia jako jedna parafia.

Aby wzmacniać naszą jedność i zaspokajać potrzeby, zaczęliśmy od oferowania lekkiego poczęstunku po każdej Mszy Św., dając nam okazję do nieformalnego spotkania się. Zapraszamy do przyłączenia się do nas w październiku.

Kontynuując, pod koniec września Cathy Walz, dyrektor ds. duszpasterstwa archidiecezji, poprowadziła sesję słuchania dla naszego personelu. Obecnie pomaga nam w przygotowaniach do sesji słuchania z udziałem wszystkich Was. Sesje te będą miały na celu zapewnienie wszystkim, którzy napotykają trudności związane z połączeniem parafii Św. Tomasza Becketa i Św. Alfonsa Liguori, **czasu na wyrażenie tych trudności, potrzeb, przemyśleń i obaw**. Odbędą się sesje poranne i wieczorne. Dаты nie zostały jeszcze ustalone, ale najprawdopodobniej odbędzie się to w pierwszym tygodniu listopada.

Oprócz tych spotkań przeprowadzimy **ankietę** skierowaną do wszystkich parafian. Będziemy pytać o Państwa opinie na temat życia sakramentalnego i duchowego, formacji wiary i edukacji, życia parafialnego i wspólnoty, działalności społecznej, komunikacji parafialnej i zarządzania, a także o inne kwestie. Ankieta odbędzie się na początku listopada. Po zakończeniu tych działań przedstawimy Parafii wszystkie wyniki.

Następnie utworzymy **nową Radę Parafialną**, która będzie współpracować ze mną, proboszczem, abyśmy mogli ustalić priorytety i wspólne działania, na podstawie tego co usłyszymy od Państwa, oparte na naszej wspólnej mądrości i wierze. Prosimy o Państwa udział i potrzebujemy go, abyśmy mogli kontynuować naszą pracę jako jedna parafia.

W międzyczasie modlę się za naszą parafię i jej przyszłość, udając się z grupą parafian na pielgrzymkę do Fatimy, Santiago de Compostela, Lourdes, Montserrat i Barcelony. Módlcie się na różańcu, jak prosiła nas Matka Boża, zwłaszcza w październiku.

We are excited to invite you to the first Youth Mass of this school year, which will take place on Sunday, October 19th at 8.30am at St Alphonsus Liguori Church.

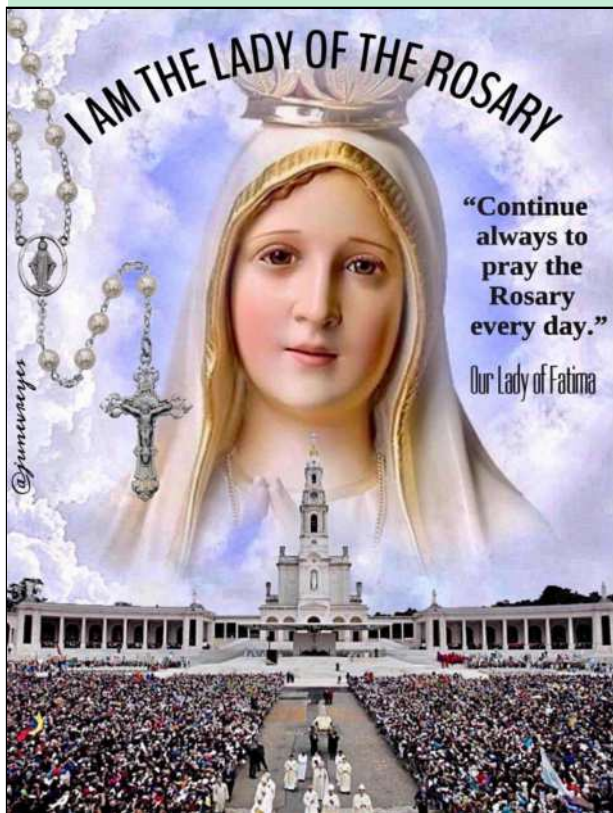
Let's come together as a faith community to celebrate Mass with the young people and begin a meaningful year of faith and fellowship.

Invitation to Holy Mass and the Fatima Procession

We warmly invite all parishioners and visitors to a **Holy Mass and Fatima Procession** on **Monday, October 13 at 7:00 PM** at **St. Thomas Becket Church**. During the procession, we will pray the **Rosary in both English and Polish**, asking Our Lady for peace, the conversion of sinners, and God's Mercy for the world.

This date marks the anniversary of the **final apparition of Our Lady in Fatima**—an event that gathered around 70,000 people in Cova da Iria (Fatima, Portugal). Despite heavy rain and mud, the people knelt with rosaries in their hands, waiting for a sign from heaven. During this final apparition, Our Lady said: **"Let people offend God no more, for He is already too much offended."**

After these words, the long-awaited miracle occurred —**"the dance of the sun"**—which led many to conversion and remains one of the most well-known signs of divine intervention in history.

Let this gathering be an opportunity for all of us to come together in prayer, reflection, and to draw closer to the heart of Mary, Our Lady of the Rosary.

"Niech ludzie już dłużej nie obrażają Boga grzechami, już i tak został bardzo obrażony."

Po tych słowach nastąpił zapowiadany cud – **"taniec słońca,"** który nawrócił wielu i do dziś pozostaje jednym z najbardziej znanych znaków Bożej interwencji w historii.

Niech to spotkanie będzie dla nas wszystkich okazją do wspólnej modlitwy, refleksji i zbliżenia się do serca Maryi, Matki Bożej Różańcowej.
