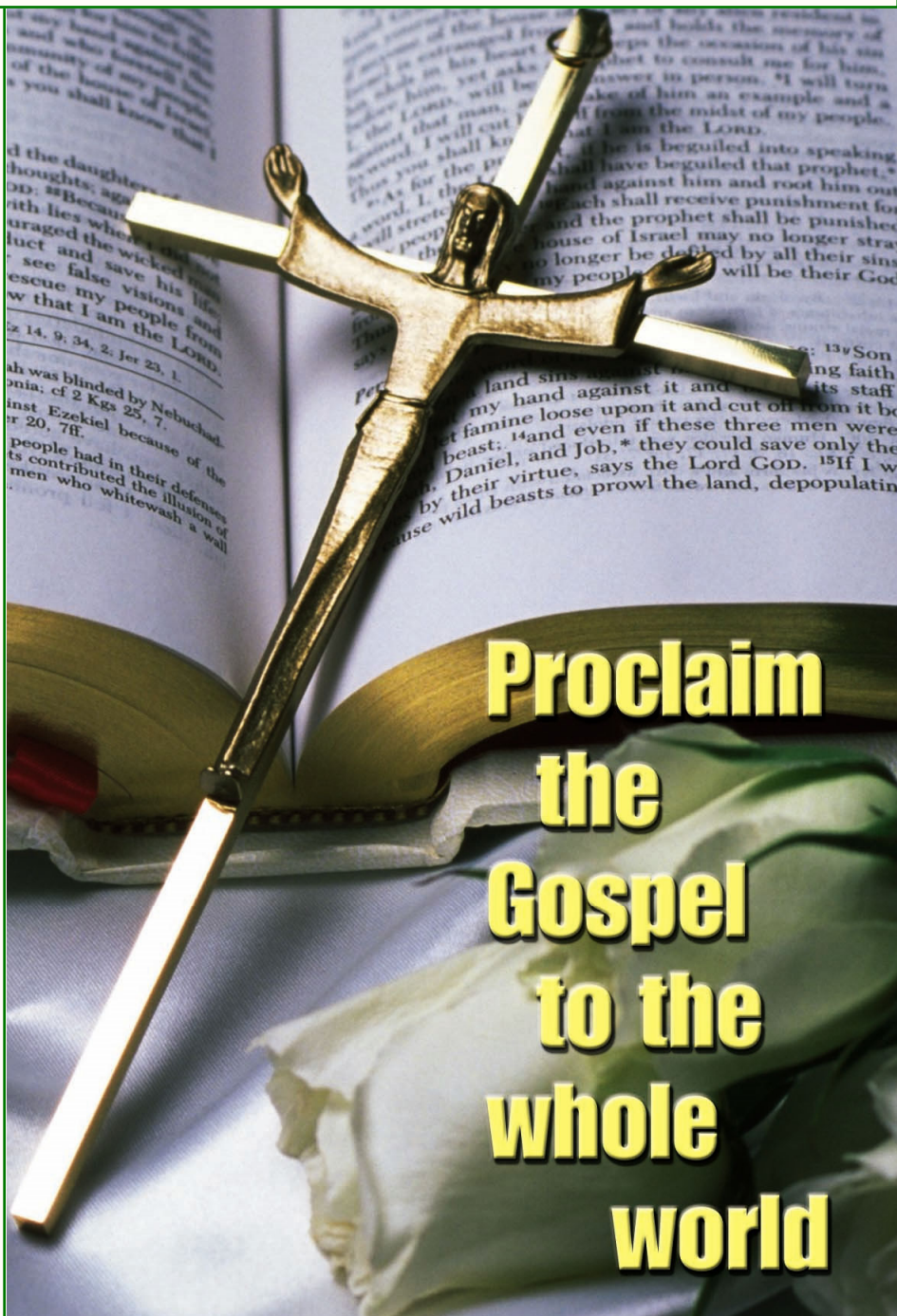

Archdiocesan Council of Catholic Women Vicariate 1 2018 Woman of the Year Award from *St Mary of Vernon Parish: Bernice Milas*

In recent years, Vicariate I Council of Catholic Women has extended a special outreach to parishes which perhaps do not have a specific Women's Group. They realize that women form the backbone of so many parish ministries, parish outreach and community building. **When a parish takes time to honor one woman, it actually draws attention to all active women, affirms all active women and expresses gratitude for the many, many women who serve the Lord and his church in local parishes.**

Some of the qualities that they look for in a "woman of the year" include: *being a welcoming person who fulfills the mission of the parish community; a woman who invites others to participate and share their skills and gifts; a woman who has given vital service to the parish and in a powerful way represents active women within the Catholic Church.*

This year, the pastoral staff, after surfacing names of many deserving recipients, chose **Bernice Milas** as a most worthy recipient. **On Wednesday, May 2nd, Mrs. Bernice Milas received the *Woman of the Year Award* at the annual awards luncheon with over 350 attending the event.**

Bernice serves in the **PREP ministry as a 2nd grade catechist** and has done so for some 28 years. She finds great joy in preparing the children to receive the sacraments of 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist. Bernice has been a **Eucharistic Minister** at the parish for 25 years and she is one of our volunteers who **launders and prepares the linens** used for Mass at the parish. She also volunteers and serves at the funeral luncheons when held at the parish.

She is part of our **Operation Reach Out (ORO)** ministry at the parish as she has two sons who are currently serving in the US Army. **ORO helps to reach out to the young men and women actively serving in the U. S. Armed Forces.** They remember those on the parish prayer list found in the bulletin each week. They recognize their accomplishments and look for ways throughout the year to show our gratitude and thanks for their service to our country. In addition, her PREP students have sent Christmas cards to those serving our country for over 25 years.

Bernice is totally humbled by this attention. However, I convinced her that this was not only good for her but good affirmation for our parish. **She is yet another amazing woman from our parish who uses her gifts and talents in the work and ministry of parish life.**

MOTHER'S DAY ROSE SALE MAY 12th & 13th

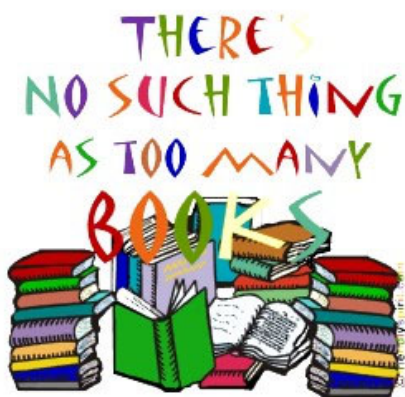


Our annual Mother's Day Rose Sale will take place at all masses on Saturday, May 12th and Sunday, May 13th.

ORDINARY GRACE BY WILLIAM KENT KREUGER.**

...Told through the voice of 13-year-old Frank Drum, minister's son, in hindsight 40 years later, "It was a summer in which death, in visitation, assumed many forms. Accident. Nature. Suicide. Murder."

One would expect, therefore, the book to be grim. But thanks to Mr. Kruger's gift with words, the story is uplifting despite the darkness of its subject. Somehow, without sentimentality or melodrama, a positive spirit emerges from the novel and leaves a warm afterglow. It proves to be a testament to ordinary grace.

The reader witnesses numerous acts of grace among characters strained by tragedy. The author is skilled in building tension, drama, and redemption. The best example of ordinary grace occurs in a sermon given by the father after burying a loved one...

...Altogether, Ordinary Grace forms a superb literary novel. It lingers in the mind long after closing the cover, and beckons one to read again for the sheer pleasure of the experience.

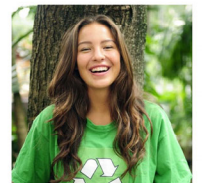

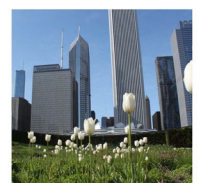

THE UNEMPLOYMENT LINE

Looking for a new job can be a full-time job – no problem if you are unemployed, but nearly impossible if you are currently working. Here's a tip about making your resume the best it can be:

The Ghost of Jobs Past - So, you decide to leave out a past position that seems to have nothing to do with the one you're applying for, when suddenly, the interviewer mentions something you have experience doing. Now what? Is it okay to bring up a past job that you haven't mentioned in your pared down resume?

What if the interviewer asks about it? Experts have questioned that, if you haven't included a job on your resume, why would you bring it up? This could be a red flag in an interview. A bigger red flag though would probably be trying to play down a situation in which the interviewer knows about your past job or specifically asks why you haven't mentioned it. In that case, don't lie or try to play it cool. Explain that you were paring down your resume and didn't think that experience best highlighted your current skill set.

If painted into a corner, try being open and the slightest bit vulnerable. Let the interviewer know that you had a rough time at that gig, and preferred to leave it in the past since you've moved on and hope your current skills, recommendations and experience speak for themselves. And then smile and wait for the next question.
