#### Advent-Christmas 2018 — New Year 2019

#### A short note from your pastor - that turned into an encyclical —what can I say?!

I guess since I am turning really old this December—and I mean, really, really old—I can't help but look back at a life amazing beyond belief, filled with wonderful family and friends, with milestones and memories.

I can't help but think of my mother who spoiled me from the start, which was quite fitting since I was the only boy with 4 sisters. She sang "You are my Sunshine" forever to put me to sleep; and my older sisters had to do it too. I do remember her telling me how she would shake me (gently, of course) when I was a skinny little kid, and tell me to "get some fat on these bones". And, of course, I know how obedient I became over the years always seeking her parental approval. (Boy, she is so happy!)

I can't help but remember being appreciated and affirmed as an altar server by the associate pastor at St. James in Maywood. I was inspired so much that I entered the seminary high school—to the bewilderment of my mother and intrigue of my family. Who would have thought that, ever a shy, retiring, "never say a word" seminarian, I would be ordained a priest - and never stop talking from then on!

I can't help but recall how supportive my family and extended family, near and far, have always been — holding me up throughout the years with prayer and encouragement.

I can't help but feel a deep gratitude as I consider how I have been blessed through my fellow priests over the years—priests who have encouraged me, put up with me and walked alongside of me in the adventure of priesthood.

I can hardly put into words how much I have been touched, formed and changed by the awesome, amazing people of God in each and every parish I came to call home—all becoming my sisters and brothers in Jesus.

I do not hesitate to acknowledge that always and everywhere it has been the people who surround me, all of you together, who have drawn the love for "pastoring" from within me.

You have taught me that, together with one another and the Lord, all things are possible. You have gifted me with your day-in and day-out witness to love and hope; to compassion and consolation; to endurance and the real joy that sharing the Good News of Jesus naturally brings.

I know that this year of transition, surrounded by the love and affection of the people and staff of St. Mary of Vernon for nearly 21 years now, will have its challenging moments for sure. But we'll be moving through the year together, so I am not afraid (well, only every few days or so, perhaps!).

## PREP & HIGH SCHOOL CONFIRMATION REGISTRATION FOR 2019 - 2020! begins WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 16, 2019 8:00 AM - 8:00 PM



It is hard to believe, but we are starting to prepare registration materials for the 2019-20 PREP year. Our first day of registration is on Wednesday, January 16, 2019 from 8am to 8pm in the Parish Center. The first day's registration forms will be processed using a lottery system. It does not matter if you register in the morning or in the evening on January 16<sup>th</sup>. However, on January 17<sup>th</sup>, all registration forms will be stamped with a date/time, and processed accordingly. Registration forms will not be mailed out, but will be available to download on the PREP page of the St. Mary of Vernon website beginning January 11<sup>th</sup> and on the first day of registration in the Parish Center. Forms cannot be turned in until January 16<sup>th</sup>. If you are new to the program, please stop by our office so we can welcome you and give you the necessary information needed to register.

There are several programs from which to choose. Please note the specific days and times and choose what works best for your family's schedule.

## To process your registration, you will need to select two choices as we cannot guarantee your first choice.

In the past, the Sunday and Summer programs have been extremely popular and we try to accommodate as many as possible. Those who do not get their first choice will be put on a waiting list and notified prior to the session if accepted.

Students must arrive on time; Early dismissal is not permitted!

The first day of registration, January 16<sup>th</sup>, is definitely our busiest. We ask for your patience and cooperation. To expedite the registration process, please have the following information ready:

- 1. Both sides of registration completed and signed.
- 2. Medical and insurance information for emergency form.
- Cash, check or charge cards accepted.
- 4. For new students: a copy of baptismal record if your child was not baptized at SMV and record of previous religious education.
- 5. All past due balances paid in full.

If you have a child (3rd grade and up) with little or no religious education, please call the PREP office to discuss placement (New Beginnings I and II). Also, please call If your child has been baptized in a faith other than the Roman Catholic tradition.

Regular consecutive attendance at our Sunday liturgies <u>and</u> in the PREP classroom is expected for all students. Class sizes are limited. <u>NO REGISTRATION FORM WILL BE PROCESSED UNLESS PAST YEARS' TUITION AND FEES HAVE BEEN PAID IN FULL</u>. We will be sending out invoices for all unpaid balances. Also, no 7th grade student will be placed into an 8th grade class unless the first year of Confirmation assignments are completed.

The PREP Office is trying to "go green" so much of our communication is done via email or texting. We are requesting that all families register with "remind.com" to facilitate this communication. Please text "@4dbdg8" to 81010 or use this QR code.



It is essential that you register as soon as possible. Many programs get closed over the first few days of registration. **Notification of your child's enrollment into a particular program will be sent via email by the end of March and only after we have all of our catechists in place.** Due to the high volume of registrations, we cannot give out that information over the phone.



We are very blessed to have over 80 PREP volunteers this year. Over the next few months, we will be putting together our volunteer roster for 2019-2020. #### REQUESTS FOR PRAYER

Our parish welcomes the opportunity to include the loved ones of parishioners in prayer. We do respect people's privacy, however; and restrict the list in the bulletin to names that have been given to us by the ailing persons themselves, or by a spouse or immediate family member. The prayers included in the Sunday liturgy petitions are for parishioners facing imminent serious surgery or death (also requested by themselves, or immediate family).

We also have a Prayer Ministry, people dedicated to praying for specific intentions. To have your intention put on the prayer list, please fill out a form by the box under the Mother Theresa picture in the narthex. These intentions are sent out weekly to our "prayer warriors", and first-names only are included.

#### PARTICIPATE IN LITURGY

Bringing the Gifts to the Altar. You are most welcome and encouraged to present the gifts at Sunday Mass. Sign up at the Welcome Desk in the Narthex. A minimum of 4 and maximum of 8 people are needed to present the gifts; but single persons as well as families can sign up to join in the procession. Just arrive 10 minutes early on that day, check your name off in the book, and let one of the ushers know you are present. They will guide you as to the procedure.

Mass Intentions read during the Prayers of the Faithful. Mass intentions can be reserved at the Narthex desk, or by visiting or calling the Parish Office. At weekday Masses and at the 5 pm and 7:45 am Masses, only one intention is allowed (although names of related family members can count as one intention). At the 9:30 am and 11:15 am Masses, we can reserve more than one intention. We request a \$10 stipend.

Votive Candles (on the east side of the sanctuary) may be reserved at the Narthex desk or at the parish office during the week. Candles last @ six days, and are changed on Saturday mornings. The donation is \$5.


