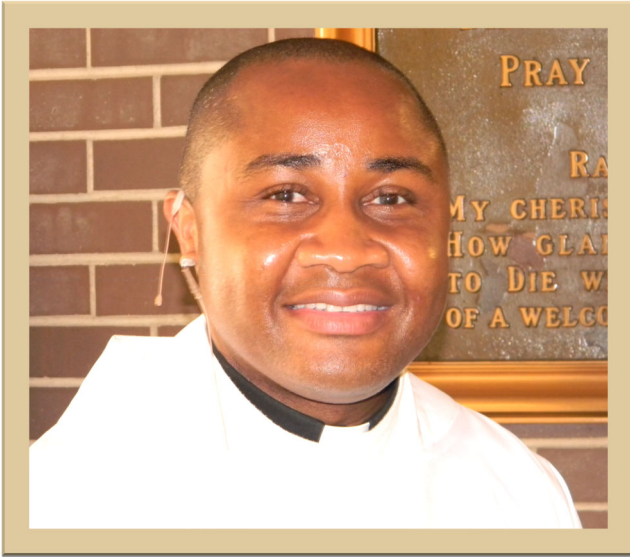

From the Pastor's desk . . .

Each of us knows a family or two where the siblings have not spoken with each other for years. When asked the cause of their dispute, you may find it was over an inheritance. In our gospel today, Jesus teaches us a lesson on greed. Imagine Jesus walking down the street. A large crowd gathered around him. He taught them about the kingdom of God, love, forgiveness, sacrifice, reconciliation, repentance, justification, etc. As people were pushing their way to get close to Jesus, someone yelled out, "Teacher, tell my brother to share the inheritance with me."

His request caught Jesus' attention. Jesus may have been surprised that in the midst of all his teachings and miracles, all this guy was concerned about was an inheritance. Jesus said to him in essence, my friend do not drag me into this matter. You go and work it out with your brother. Jesus used that opportunity to teach the crowd a lesson on greed. He advises us to guard against all forms of greed.

Merriam-Webster defines greed as "a selfish and excessive desire for more of something (such as money) than is needed, motivated by naked ambition." Greed is selfishly accumulating material things over and above what one needs. This does not mean God does not bless us with excessive material wealth. God does. The reason God blesses us with excessive material wealth is for us to be a blessing to others. Jesus tells us "though one may be rich, one's life does not consist of possessions." In other words, material wealth does not constitute the fullness of life. Material things, on their own, will not bring one contentment. What brings fulfillment, joy, hope, peace, in addition to everlasting life, is what one does with material things.

RCIA – KNOW SOMEONE SEARCHING FOR GOD IN THEIR LIFE?

Some wisdom to share with a friend, family member, neighbor, or co-worker who is searching for God...from the Word On Fire Blog (www.wordonfire.org) – a reason to consider the Catholic Church:

CATHOLICISM IS BIBLICAL

The primary source that supports all the Catholic Church teaches, both theologically and historically, is the written Word of God. Yes, we also believe that we are saved by faith—but not “by faith alone” because that’s what the Bible says (James 2:24). We believe true faith works in love and thus we must “work out our salvation with fear and trembling” (Gal 5:6; Phil 2:12). We believe that the deposit of faith has been passed down through the Sacred Writings and also by sacred oral tradition because that’s what Paul taught (1 Thess 2:13; 2 Thess 2:15; 1 Cor 11:2). We believe that the grace required for our salvation comes freely through the sacraments, beginning with baptism, because the New Testament says things like “Baptism...now saves you” (1 Pet 3:21).

We also believe in the authority of the Church as the teacher and interpreter of the faith. Jesus makes the final authority of the Church clear in Matthew 18 and, furthermore, St. Paul calls the Church “the pillar and bulwark of truth” (1 Tim 3:15). And, we believe in the Eucharist because Jesus said “unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood you have no life in you” and “my flesh is food indeed”. “Do this”, said Jesus. And to this day the Catholic Church continues to do this in memory of Christ making present today the once for all sacrifice of Jesus on Calvary. The Eucharistic sacrifice is a re-presentation and *this* is the source and summit of the Christian life.

That is why a Eucharistic Church is the final resting place for every human. It is the one place where spiritual *and* bodily communion is possible with God in this life: and from that one great meeting with God flow all kinds of extraordinary possibilities.

The RCIA team invites all our parishioners and guests to continue praying for our candidate – Hannah – and our seeker – Jessica – and our sponsors, teams of catechists, our neighbors who are being called back to the Church, and all those who are seeking to better understand their relationship with God. 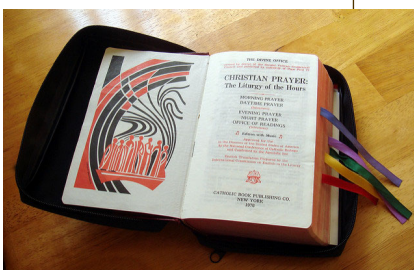

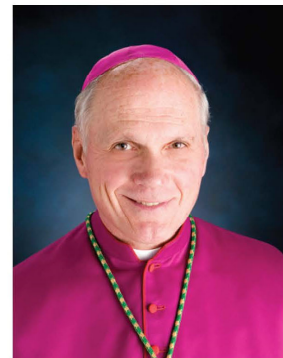

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Apart from the period from Thanksgiving through Christmas, the summer is a favored time for family reunions. We trace family trees and recall our origins. Worship has a family tree as well, and the way we celebrate today has been influenced by various styles and customs through the centuries. We are Western Christians of the Latin Rite. By far, we are the most numerous Western Christians, but there are other ritual families as well. The Archdiocese of Milan in Italy follows the Ambrosian Rite, Toledo in Spain preserves the Mozarabic Rite and the Arab language, and Lyons in France is home to the Gallican Rite. Other liturgical families, such as the Celtic in Ireland and the Sarum in England, faded away after the Reformation. Until recent times, members of some ancient religious orders such as Carmelites and Trappists followed a pattern of Mass that varied slightly from the plan observed in Latin Rite parishes.

Isn't the Catholic Church the same everywhere? Not at all. It never has been! The existence of so many liturgical families in the West reminds us that unity, not uniformity, is what the Church seeks to achieve among her children. We are united in faith, but wonderfully diverse in rituals, ceremonies, languages, customs, and spirituality.
