It has been a long standing tradition of the Catholic Church to remember and pray for our deceased brothers and sisters. During the month of November we do so in a very special way as we celebrate the Feast of All Souls.

Besides our earlier Mass on All Soul's Day morning (8:30AM) we invite all parishioners and friends of Saint Mary of Vernon to gather with one another and join us for a special mid-morning liturgy during which we will pray in a special way for the deceased loved ones of the members and friends of our Saint Mary of Vernon Family.

Saturday, November 2, 2019 Saint Mary of Vernon Church at 10:00 A.M.

Hospitality will be held immediately after the Liturgy. We hope you will join us!

In preparation, there will be two special ways to remember your loved ones by name:

- * This weekend a "Book of Remembrance" is on display in the narthex (east side near front entranceway). This "sacred space" will give you the opportunity to remember and pray for your deceased loved one. Please stop by and write the names of your deceased relatives and friends in the "Book of the Names of the Dead". If you wrote the names in last year, these names are already in the Book and will be prayed for again at this Liturgy this year and throughout November. If you have not written the names of your loved ones in this book as yet or if there are new names to add, please do so as you leave church before November 2. This book will be presented to God during our All Souls liturgy and will be in the narthex for prayer throughout the month of November.
- * As you enter Church the morning of this All Soul's Liturgy, you will also be invited to write the names of your loved ones on a keepsake Memorial Card. This memento will be presented in prayer by those present during the liturgy and placed before the altar. These Memorial Cards will be yours to keep at the end of the Mass.




WEDDING ANNIVERSARY MASS & DINNER DANCE Saturday, November 2, 2019



Over the last three years, our income has been decreasing at a progressive rate due to multiple factors, including decreases in active parishioners, decreases in contributing parishioners and decreased or stagnant giving.

At the same time, despite our best efforts, expenses continue to rise just like they do in your own homes. .

We have had to rely on our Annual Catholic Appeal rebate and increasingly on our savings to meet our ordinary expenses for the past fiscal year and the current fiscal year. If we continue to do so at the current rate we risk depleting our savings entirely in the next 12 months.

We continue to support all of our important parish functions and ministries which require funding, including Religious Education, Youth Ministry, Adult Faith Formation, Deacon Training, and Educational and Professional Enrichment.



during his career. He has deployed in support of Counterterrorism and




