SOMETHING NEW RECEIVE EUCHARIST FROM YOUR CAR

We are in our 5th month of celebrating public Mass in our Church under the pandemic guidelines. Since Labor Day we have been averaging 262 attendees per weekend. Since our weekend limit is 300 you can see that we still have room for more people to attend.

We recently had professional grade cameras permanently installed in the church to improve the quality of our live stream productions and to enable us to live stream every Mass. Looking forward to Christmas, these cameras will also give us the opportunity to simulcast Mass directly into the Parish Center for overflow crowds.

Now that we can live stream every Mass we would like to offer people the opportunity to receive Eucharist from your car in the Church parking lot after the 8am Mass. If you are not ready to come to Mass inside Church you can watch it at home or drive to the parish and watch it from your car on your smartphone. Father Ignatius will distribute Eucharist from the main entrance of church starting around 9:15am.

Some logistics:

If you are going to watch Mass on your smartphone from your car we ask you to park in the south auxiliary parking lot. This would be to avoid the cars that are parked for Mass attendees.

Once Mass is over and the parking lot cleared, around 9:15 am, you can begin to form a line of cars in front of church from the south parking lot, running along the detention pond, then turning the car to face west, passenger side next to church.

Fr. Ignatius will be standing under the awning in front of Church.

Everyone in the car should wear their mask. Remain in your car. A hand sanitizer volunteer will come to each car, walking around the car to sanitize each person's hands. Father will follow and distribute the Eucharist. Do not remove your mask until everyone in your car has received and Fr. Ignatius has moved away from your car. Once Father has passed your car you can consume the host. If your car does not have windows to access everyone in the car, tell Father and he will give you instructions.

Once everyone in your car has received you can leave the parking lot toward the west. Father will stay in front of the church and the next car can pull up to where he is standing.

Please note that this is all predicated on the weather. Father will not be able to distribute the Eucharist if it is actively raining, snowing or the temperature drops below freezing.

Attending Mass in the COVID-19 Era

We have three regular weekend Masses with a total seating capacity of 330 people, 110 at each Mass. **All three Masses (5pm, 8am & 11am) are live-streamed on Facebook. Sign up for Sunday and Daily Masses is required through Sign Up Genius or by calling the parish office at 847-362-1005.** Sign up for Daily Mass at <https://tinyurl.com/yaymo6v2>. Sign up for Saturday night & Sunday Masses at <https://tinyurl.com/y9823aam>. Sign Up Genius reservations will close at **noon on Saturdays**.

Please remember to arrive 20 minutes early. The Church doors will be locked 5 minutes after Mass starts. We understand that there are a lot of "rules" to attend Mass, so please understand that the guidelines we are following are from the Archdiocese and civil authorities with the intention of keeping everyone as safe as possible.

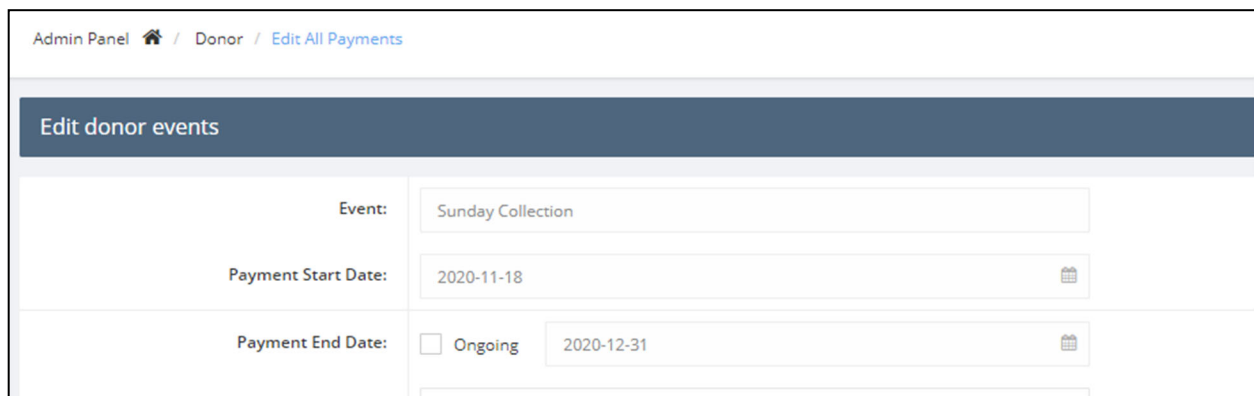
GIVE CENTRAL UPDATE

We are living through some challenging times. Back in March when we closed our Churches for the first time in memorable history no one thought the pandemic would last this long or have such far reaching affects. Even when we re-opened our Church doors on June 7, we did not think we would have to celebrate the approaching holidays with apprehension and uncertainty.

A year ago we had a successful increased offering campaign when we encouraged parishioners to use electronic giving to keep our parish income consistent each month. It really worked. This past quarter over 40% of our income came from online giving. The rest came from the Sunday Church collection boxes and the mail-in envelopes.

As we approach the end of the year, we are asking everyone who uses Give Central to pay close attention to the ending date on their account. You may have already received an email reminder from Give Central if your donations are set to **expire on or around the end of 2020**. It is important that you log into your Give Central account at www.givecentral.org and edit your primary information screen to reflect a new expiration date, if necessary. Some instructions to make it easier:

From the Donor Screen look for the Current Event – Sunday Collection. On the right side of that line you will see some small boxes, you can select the first or second box. This will take you to Edit Donor Event where you will see:

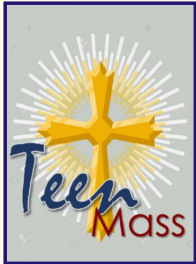

SMV CHRISTMAS GIFT PROGRAM

We have a beautiful tradition at St. Mary of Vernon of sharing Christmas with the less fortunate. This year we will again offer our people the opportunity to give a Christmas present to a needy person who might otherwise be forgotten. It is especially important this year to provide a level of normalcy for our client families and especially the children amidst all the disruption to their lives resulting from the COVID virus. The program will be limited to the 450 names from Sharing Hands.

The logistics of the program will be modified to conform to safety precautions for our parishioners and the client family members. Distribution of the tags previously displayed on tables in the Narthex will be replaced by selecting individuals through SignUpGenius. Each of the slots will contain the same information as the tags, with the individual's name, their sizes, and gift preference. The link for this program will be made available next week along with detailed instructions for usage. You are invited to pick a name and buy a gift for that person, wrap it, attach the Sharing Hands number and recipient name on the package, and then drop it off at the Parish Center on the last weekend in November (see times printed on gift tags below). Unfortunately, the normal Gift Sunday collection of gifts is not practical due to safety protocols. Gift certificates are also welcome and acceptable. Thank you for your continued support of this program as we all struggle with the impact of the virus. The distribution of these gifts will definitely brighten Christmas for our Sharing Hands families.

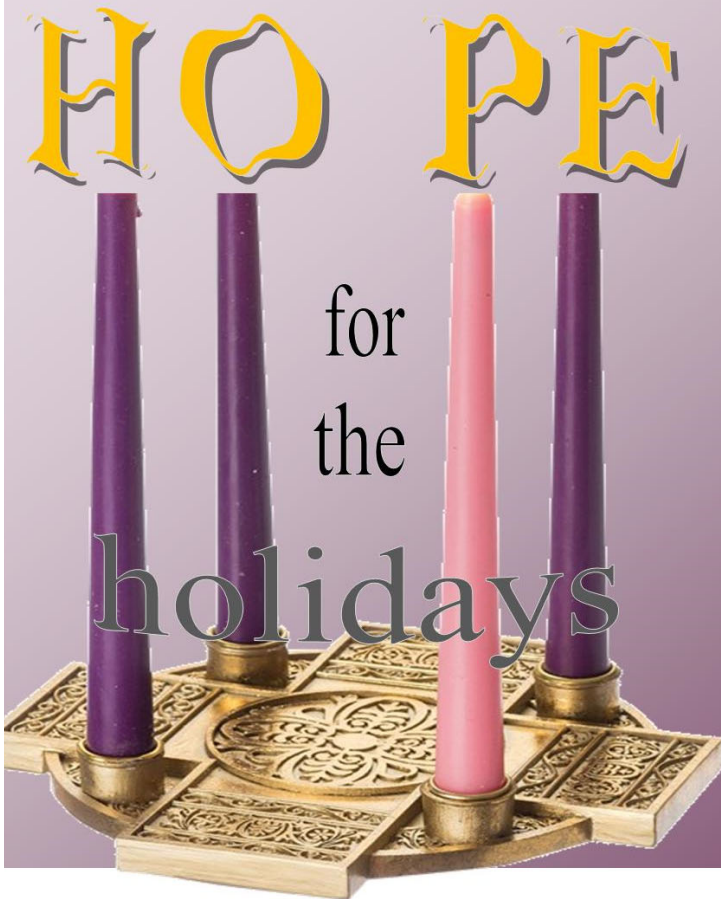

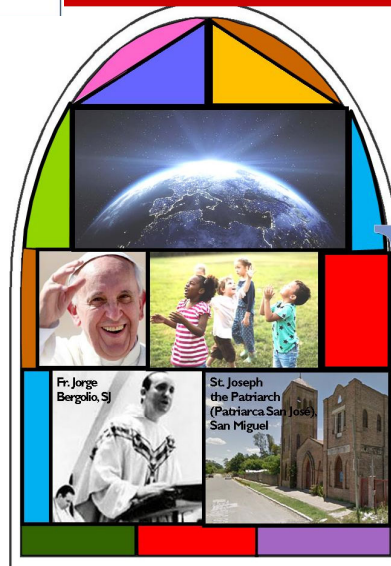


Catholic Charities Meals on Wheels Drivers Needed.
