*The **Diocese of Kiyinda-Mityana** is located in a rural region of Uganda. The diocese will soon begin celebrating its 40-year anniversary. One major goal for this year is to provide clean drinking water to all regions. The diocese has already begun to distribute small water containers to various households for the storage of drinking water. As well, the diocese intends to provide poly-fiber tanks to all diocesan Catholic schools. The filters make it safer for consumption as rainwater is a proven source of clean and safe water. Many water sources located in low areas become polluted in the rainy season. This will ensure accessibility to clean and safe water and hygienic practices like frequent washing of hands.*

August's festivals of Transfiguration and Assumption have long given Christians the best of excuses for feasting on the abundance of summer: corn, tomatoes, pesto, bowls of fresh fruit. Picnics are a sign of the welcome table of God: always room for one more, always plenty to share, always a place of laughter and story-telling and always speaking to us of our deepest longings. Don't let August pass by without a picnic!

FEAST OF FAITH

The Preface: Thanksgiving

The preface of the Mass has been called “a poem, the cry of joy and recognition, the song of the world discovering its salvation . . . the certitude of faith making hope spring forth” (Philippe Béguerie, quoted in *The Mass*, Lucien Deiss, The Liturgical Press, Collegeville, MN, 1992, p. 70). The preface takes up the last words of the dialogue, and expresses briefly and simply why we are grateful, why it is right and just to give thanks and praise to God. On feast days, the preface sings of the specific mystery or saint we celebrate; in Ordinary Time, the Sunday and weekday prefaces express our gratitude for God’s gift of the Son, Jesus Christ, in whom we have redemption and newness of life. The prefaces offer a succinct account of what God has done for us in Christ; they express the mystery of faith, always relating it to us, to our lives. “By his birth we are reborn,” we hear in Preface IV for Sundays in Ordinary Time. “By his suffering we are freed from sin. By his rising from the dead we rise to everlasting life.” Yes, we have cause to give God thanks and praise.

WHAT YOU EAT MATTERS!

Meat production accounts for about 15% of climate warming greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions. Most meat comes from factory farms that are heavily polluting. Cutting back or changing the mix of meats you eat can have a big environmental impact, and can improve your health. Here is EWG's comparison of CO₂ emissions/unit of meat to your plate:

- Chicken rated as the best meat
- Pork, turkey, farmed salmon and cheese are almost 2x worse than chicken
- Beef is 4x worse than chicken
- Lamb is 5x worse than chicken
