## Monthly Anointing of the Sick Beginning...

Beginning October 23<sup>rd</sup> and every 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday of the month after, the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will be offered at the 8:30 Mass.

**Scriptural basis:** “Is any among you sick? Let them call for the presbyters of the Church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord; and the prayer of faith will save the sick man, and the Lord will raise him up; and if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven” (Jas 5:14-15).

### Who can receive the sacrament?

All who are experiencing illness, old age or anticipating a surgery may receive this sacrament as well as those who are dying.

### How is it celebrated?

The anointing of the forehead and hands of the sick person is accompanied by prayer, laying on of hands and Scripture reading. The communal celebration of the sacrament is appropriately celebrated during the Mass.

### What are the sacrament’s effects?

The sick person is united to the passion of Christ, receives strength, peace and courage to endure the sufferings of illness or old age, the forgiveness of sins, and preparation for passing over to eternal life for those who may be dying.



## GIFT SUNDAY 2021

As you may recall, last Christmas' Gift Sunday was changed to a much-modified version due to the COVID pandemic. While things have improved, we know many of our parishioners are still not comfortable returning to Church. So, this year we are going to try a hybrid version of this endearing St. Mary's tradition.

Last year we only accepted gifts for our Sharing Hands clients via **SignUpGenius**. This year we are going to include children and vulnerable seniors from Lake County Catholic Charities as well. To participate in the Gift Program, you will have the option of selecting a name tag from the tables in the narthex, as we have done in the past, or you can check out **SignUpGenius** on line and find a giftee there. The name tags and **SignUpGenius** will be available starting **November 13-14**.

Our traditional Gift Sunday will be on the weekend of **December 4-5** at all Masses. Your wrapped gifts can be brought to Mass that day and brought to the altar at the Offertory. After Mass they will be sorted and then distributed the following week. We anticipate that there will be a smaller number of gifts to sort after the last Mass, but we will still welcome volunteers to help get the gifts sorted and sent off to Catholic Charities or Sharing Hands.

You will also have the option of dropping off your gifts at the Parish Center if you do not want to bring them to Mass. Drop off times will be announced.

Two very important things to remember:

The gift tag must be securely attached to the wrapped gift as this is the only way we can get it to the right recipient. The gifts must be returned before noon on December 5<sup>th</sup>.

Gift Sunday is just one example of the generosity of our parish family. Giving to the less fortunate has been a hall mark of this parish from the very beginning. So, even during this stress filled time we are glad we are able to bring back this long standing tradition to our parish.



## WHAT IS DOMESTIC VIOLENCE?

Domestic violence (also known as spouse abuse, partner violence, intimate-partner violence, battering, and numerous other terms) is a pattern of coercion used by one person to exert power and control over another person in the context of a dating, family, or household relationship. The spectrum of domestic violence includes much more than physical assault. Domestic violence encompasses a constellation of controlling behaviors.

Domestic violence is learned, purposeful behavior and is a manifestation of the abuser's need to achieve and maintain power and control over the victim. The single most influential factor of domestic violence in adulthood is domestic violence in the household in which the person was reared.





**WEEKLY STEWARDSHIP RECOMMENDATION**

**Reduce car idling to save money and reduce pollution.**

Unnecessary vehicle idling wastes six billion gallons of fuel per year, contributing to smog and air pollution according to the U.S. Dept. of Energy. These emissions make air unhealthy, especially for children and elderly people, and increase the likelihood of global warming.

Except in traffic, turn the engine off if you'll be static for more than 10 seconds, especially while running an errand, waiting for someone, or at a long stop like a railroad crossing. With modern engines, idling is actually harder on your engine than shutting it off. Even in the winter don't idle a cold engine for more than 30 seconds because engines warm up better by being driven gently.
