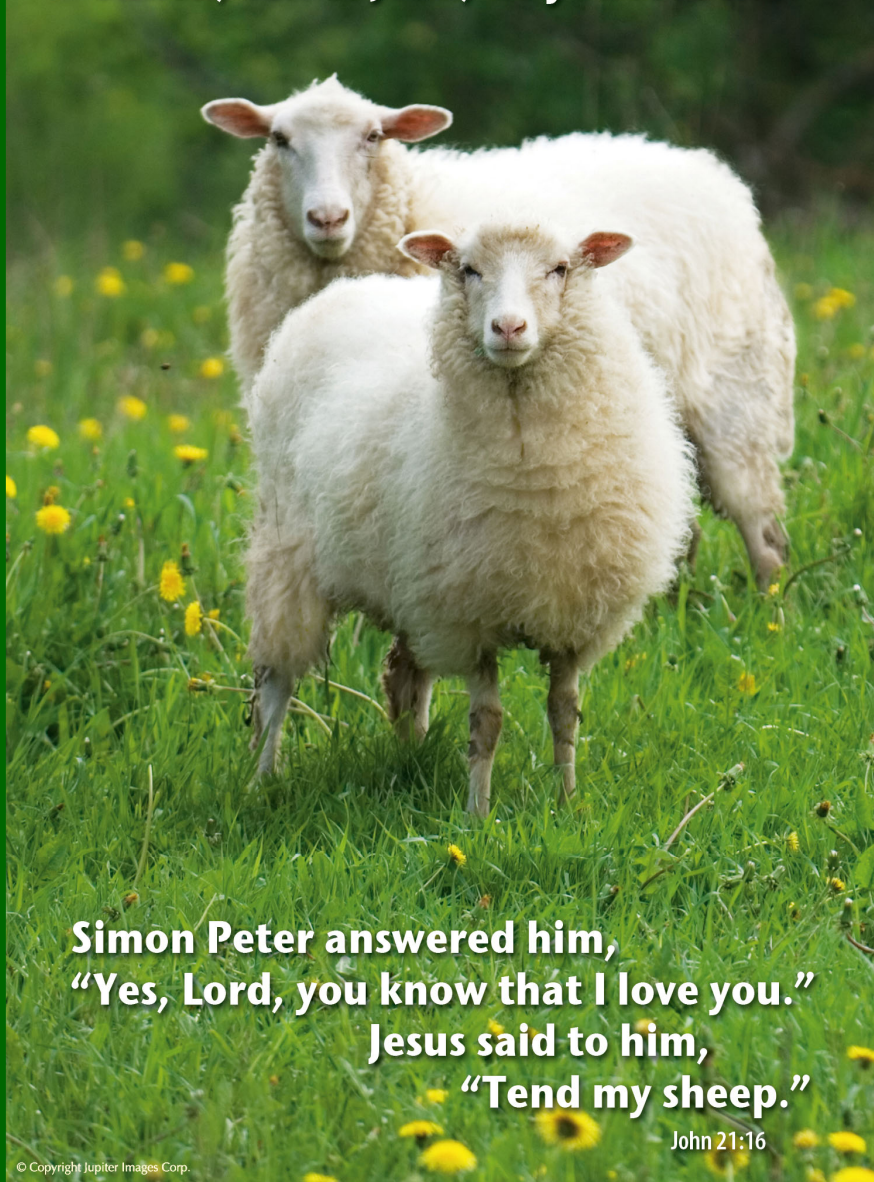

And what great timing! St Mary of Vernon just completed the Pope's call for feedback to the Synod process that runs through 2023, and there is a lot of information from our parishioners to ponder. As a PPC member, you will be planning and executing our own parish's **mission**, supporting its **ministries**, and continuing the process of **re-awakening** from the pandemic - as we welcome back all of our members to a vibrant community that is ready to assist their journey through life. Simply put, PPC members will help to plan and implement short- and long-term strategies to live the Gospel.

Through facilitated prayer and discussion, those who stepped forward with an openness to the possibility of serving on the PPC will discern among themselves who is called to be on the council for the next term.
