



Monthly Anointing of the Sick

Every 4th Saturday of the month (this month it is April 22), the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will be offered at the 8:30 a.m. Mass.

Who can receive the sacrament? All who are experiencing illness, old age or anticipating a surgery may receive this sacrament as well as those who are dying.

How is it celebrated? The anointing of the forehead and hands of the sick person is accompanied by prayer, laying on of hands and Scripture reading. The communal celebration of the sacrament is appropriately celebrated during the Mass.

What are the sacrament's effects? The sick person is united to the passion of Christ, receives strength, peace and courage to endure the sufferings of illness or old age, the forgiveness of sins, and preparation for passing over to eternal life for those who may be dying.




A Message From Our Pastor . . .




