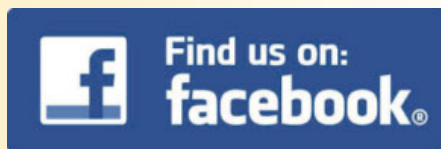

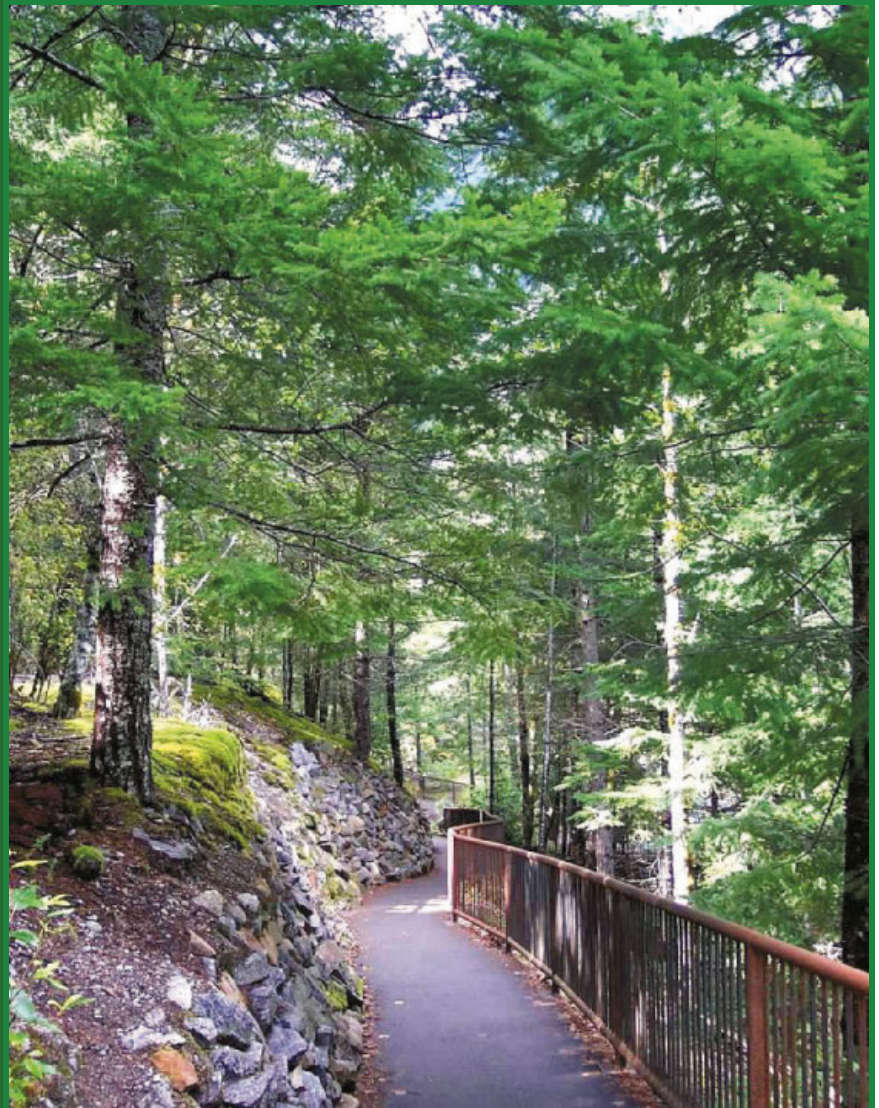
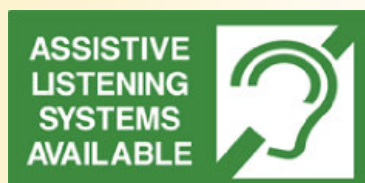

## PARTICIPATE IN THE WEEKEND LITURGY

**Bringing the Gifts to the Altar.** You are most welcome and encouraged to present the gifts at Sunday Mass. Sign up at the Welcome Desk in the Narthex. A minimum of 4 and maximum of 8 people are needed to present the gifts; but single persons as well as families can sign up to join in the procession. Just arrive 10 minutes early on that day, check your name off in the book, and let one of the ushers know you are present. They will guide you as to the procedure.

**Mass Intentions read during the Prayers of the Faithful.** Mass intentions can be reserved at the Narthex desk, or by visiting or calling the Parish Office. At weekday Masses and at the 5pm and 7:45am Masses, only one intention is allowed (although names of related family members can count as one intention). At the 9:30am and 11:15am Masses, we can reserve more than one intention. We request a \$10 stipend.

**Votive Candles** (on the east side of the sanctuary) **may be reserved at the Narthex desk or at the parish office during the week.** Candles last for six days, and are changed on Saturday mornings. Donation is \$5.

**A COVE ALLIANCE SPONSOR'S REFLECTION**  
**"I greet you in the name of Jesus Christ".**  
**"I pray that God keeps you and your family safe".**

This is how Vivian's letters usually begin, with a drawing of a big heart that says "I Love You".

I was blessed to meet Vivian in the summer of 2017, when Darlene, Aurelia, Carolyn and I had the opportunity to go to Kapeeka, Uganda to help the children of St. Jerome Cove School. It was an experience that was life changing for me. I'll never forget seeing Vivian for the very first time as Joseph pulled up in front of her home. She was wearing a bright red cotton dress and she greeted me with the most brilliant smile. She was excited because she had just learned that she would be able to go to the St. Jerome School. I was excited because I was given the privilege of meeting the young child that I would be sponsoring. Upon our meeting there was a joy that I can't even begin to describe. I guess you could say that we both felt a kindred bond, despite having never met before and living miles apart from each other. We surely felt the presence of the Holy Spirit. Vivian couldn't wait to introduce me to her father and baby brother. I was humbled as I witnessed this young child's spirit.



When Vivian started school, we exchanged letters. After her beautiful greeting she always wrote that she was doing her best and that she was working hard so that she could be a nurse, which was her lifelong dream. As the letters continued to come she mentioned that school was becoming more difficult but that she was working hard in her studies, determined to fulfill her dream of becoming a nurse. Her report cards showed her grades as being less than average with comments from the teachers stating that she was capable of doing much better. By the grace of God one of her teacher's commented that Vivian was having trouble with her eyes, that she was having difficulty seeing the board, even when sitting in the front of the classroom. Because sponsors can network with COVE in Uganda these concerns were expressed to Fr. Hilary and he had her vision checked. It was determined that Vivian did indeed have poor vision that could be corrected with glasses. Happily Vivian's grades are improving and her confidence is improving as she works toward her goal of becoming a nurse.

Now it is a priority that all children at St. Jerome are screened on a regular basis so that each child can work to his/her full potential and become successful.

As I reflect on our visit to St. Jerome Cove School and meeting my sponsored child, I feel so blessed that Vivian gifted me with her joy-filled spirit. This is something that will remain in my heart forever. I pray that others will have the opportunity to experience this too, thanks be to God.

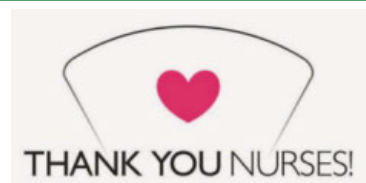

### Managing Runoff with Rain Gardens

Managing stormwater runoff in our yards and communities is challenging but important. Left unchecked, stormwater carries pollutants from roofs, chemically treated lawns, driveways and roads into streams and waterways. Increasing ways for water to be absorbed through landscaping makes for healthier land and water for all.

One home solution is the "rain garden." Rain gardens are shallow depressions filled with perennial native plants which temporarily collect a few inches of rain. Plant roots then slowly filter out pollutants and allow the water to percolate into the surrounding soil. Up to 30% more water is absorbed into the ground. Besides alleviating problems associated with flooding and drainage, rain gardens can beautify yards, recharge the ground water supply and provide habitat and food for wildlife, including birds and butterflies.
