


NEW MAINTENANCE MAN ON BOARD!

Thank you to our children!



Last weekend we witnessed our children make their donation to the “For our Future” Campaign. I was awestruck to see the little ones, some of them barely old enough to walk, with little buckets of coins in hands, they walked down the aisle and poured those coins into a container in front of the altar. The sound those coins made when they were poured into the container reminded me of the story of the widow’s mite. I am truly grateful to our children for their generosity.

Several months ago, after we had made the decision to go ahead with this campaign, we formed various cabinets such as the “Prayer Cabinet,” “Hospitality Cabinet,” “Youth and Children’s Cabinet,” etc. The function of the “Youth and Children’s Cabinet” was to speak with our children, especially children in our Religious Education Program, on how they can donate toward the “For our Future” Campaign. The children made some boxes where they collected their coins. They did this for several months. Two weeks ago was the last religious education class of the year. When the children attended that last class, they donated the coins they had saved toward our “For our Future” Campaign.

One of our catechists told me the story of a student in her class, Ismael. Ismael had forgotten to bring his collected coin box on the last day of class. As other students made their donations, Ismael told his teacher he would bring his box of coins to the next class. The catechist reported saying to Ismael, “But, today is the last day of class.” Ismael felt so bad he had forgotten his coins.

At the end of class, as students were leaving the classroom, Ismael walked to his teacher, reached into his pocket, brought out three dollars and gave them to his teacher for the campaign. He told his teacher he felt bad when he could not donate at the time other students were making their donations. Ismael gave three dollars of his own money, not money handed to him by his father or mother but his own money. I am truly grateful to Ismael and parishioners like him who have made great sacrifices for this campaign. Our children donated \$679.77 in coins and \$1092.00 in dollars. With the youth and children’s donation of \$1771.77, I am pleased to announce to you that we have exceeded our minimum campaign goal of \$1,500,000. We have pledges totaling \$1,541,849.77 from 268 families. Thank you! I am truly excited and grateful. Our focus now is to reach our challenge goal of \$2,000,000. This will fully fund all our planned improvements and establish a “Future Fund” for ongoing facility maintenance. Remember this is a three-year commitment. Also, every penny donated toward this campaign stays at SMV.

I am indeed truly grateful for your generosity. May the promise of the Lord in 1 Kings 17:16 remain always with you and your loved ones. Amen!

Consider Joining the St. Mary of Vernon PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL (PPC)

Parishioners have the opportunity to share responsibility for pastoral life at St. Mary of Vernon under the leadership of its pastor through the Parish Pastoral Council (PPC). Members will help to plan and implement short and long term strategies to grow our faith community and live the Gospel.

Our Parish Council is planning to fill the expiring terms of two members to maintain its full complement of twelve. The council needs a variety of ages, experiences and backgrounds to reflect the needs of the dynamic community that is St. Mary of Vernon.

PPC Members will be available in the Narthex after Masses on the weekend of May 6/7 to share information and answer questions.

The **discernment process** takes place on **Saturday, May 13 from 8:30 a.m. Mass until around noon**. Through facilitated prayer and discussion, those who stepped forward with an openness to the possibility of serving on the PPC discern among themselves who is called to be on the council for the next term.

For our Future Campaign Payment Options

Thank you for your pledge to our parish's *For our Future Campaign*. The next step is how to pay your pledge. You will be mailed a statement - payment schedule. The information was taken from your pledge card, please check it over to see that the payment schedule meets your intentions. If necessary, adjustments can be made at any time by contacting the parish office at 847-362-1005 or via email to forourfuture@maryofvernon.org

There are several ways to make your payments.

1. Starting with the May June envelope packets there will be a new *For our Future* envelope specifically for the campaign. This will replace the Building Fund envelope we were previously using. You can use this envelope at any time and place it in the regular collection basket. Please make all checks for the campaign to St. Mary of Vernon and separate from your Sunday donation. The envelopes will be sorted by the money counters and handled separately from the regular Sunday collection.
2. For those who wish to use electronic transactions, you can set up an account through Give Central at www.givecentral.org. The QR code here will take you right to their page. Give Central will accept credit cards and bank ACH transactions.

- You will be asked the amount of your payment (not the total you pledged, but what your regular payment will be). You can get this from your enclosed statement.
- The date you want to start your payments (May or June) - you can select what day of the month.
- The frequency of your payments, monthly, quarterly, annually, etc.
- Asked if you want to cover the processing fees. All electronic payments cost the parish money by way of fees; it will be helpful if you are able to cover the cost.



If you already have a Give Central account, you just need to log in to the program and add *For Our Future* as a new event.

3. Direct payments from your bank or IRA accounts can be made to the parish. You can mail your payment directly to the parish, have it sent directly from your banking institution or set up St. Mary of Vernon as a vendor through your bank's electronic bill paying feature and have your pledge payments sent directly to us. Please make sure your payment is clearly identified as to whom it is from and that it is for the campaign.
