



#### **For Our Future Update**

As of Tuesday, June 26th, we have \$1,767,837 pledged and \$436,137 cash in the bank from 357 donors. We are very excited to announce that our first project is the sound system in church. Installation should be complete this weekend. The old sound system was over 20 years old. Parts of it were outdated and could no longer be repaired.

After obtaining several references and quotes, and meeting with multiple vendors, we signed a contract with **Sound Planning** out of Wheaton. \$106,461 was set aside for the project. All contracts have been reviewed and approved by the Archdiocese of Chicago.

Slip-n-Slide Kickball Wednesday, July 5th 6:30-8:30 PM




