


Golden Wedding Anniversary Mass For those married in 1973

The SMV Men's Club normal September meeting will not take place. Members are encouraged to put their energy into volunteering to work at the Oktoberfest on September 30th. The next regular meeting will be October 16th.

SMV Shelters the Homeless

St. Mary of Vernon hosts guests at our PADS homeless shelter every Thursday evening through Friday morning from October 1 through April 30. Following are the tasks so dutifully accomplished by our army of volunteers.

First Shift (5:15 - 8:00 p.m.) This is the shift in which we set up the sleeping accommodations and serve supper to our guests. It requires setting up removable wall dividers, dispersing floor pads and making them into beds, arranging and setting the tables, preparing the food and serving it and clearing the tables (10-15 people).

Second Shift (8:00 - 11:00 p.m.) This is the shift in which the kitchen is cleaned and the next day's sack lunches are prepared. We also serve refreshments while our guests watch a movie (7-8 people).

Third Shift (11:00 p.m. - 3:00 a.m.) This is largely a caretaker shift. It may be necessary to finish the lunches, or make sure the kitchen is clean for breakfast; but it normally allows time for the volunteers to catch up on their reading or laptop computer work (3 people).

Fourth Shift (3:00 - 6:30 a.m.) This shift continues in the caretaker role for the early part of the shift; but at about 5:00 a.m. breakfast is started. Serving breakfast, tearing down, and cleaning up (with the help of the fifth shift overlap) make this shift plenty active (3 people).

Fifth Shift (5:15 - 6:45 a.m.) This shift is short, but labor-intensive. Serve breakfast, tear down and clean up. It dovetails most easily with the normal workday for most (8 people).

PADS also maintains a substitute list because unforeseen circumstances might cause a regular shift volunteer to be otherwise committed when they are scheduled to serve. There is currently a need to increase the size of the substitute list. Most volunteers serve once per month, but some serve more frequently - volunteer's choice.
