



# <u>FAQS</u>



When does this Book Study begin? Books will be distributed February 10 & 11 after Mass, with the first group meeting sometime during that week, prior to February 17 & 18 weekend.

Who can participate? Everyone! We encourage parents to talk to their children, teens, & adults to form small groups.





Contrary to some rumors there are no plans to put an ICE RINK in the narthex.






