5th Sunday in Ordinary Time B

Our first reading from the Book of Job ends with the line, “I shall not see happiness again.” What a sad ending. This book is named after its main character, Job. It deals with the issue of suffering, especially the suffering of the innocent.

Job was a pious man who was immensely blessed by God. Satan claimed Job was pious because he had been blessed. In Satan’s opinion, were Job to suffer any form of hardship, he would sin against God. God gave Satan permission to tempt Job, “only do not lay a hand on his person” (Jb. 1:12) and “spare his life” (Jb. 2:6), God said. As the story unfolds, Job receives a series of bad news. He ends up losing everything. Hence his words in our first reading today, “Is not man’s life on earth a drudgery? Are not his days those of a hireling? He is a slave who longs for the shade, a hireling who waits for his wages.” Job’s suffering asks the question of why do the innocent suffer?

When God addresses this issue in chapter 38, God did not answer the above question. Rather, God speaks about his omniscience and almighty power. God leads Job to a broader understanding of the mystery of God and life. The human mind is too small to understand divine plans. We can never see the whole picture from this side of existence, perhaps in heaven we might. God is the only one who sees, and knows, how parts of our life relate to the whole. As a result, the right attitude towards God in the face of suffering is humility and trust, trust in the graciousness of God and God’s faithfulness.

Next weekend we will listen to the Cardinal’s recorded homily for the 2024 Annual Catholic Appeal. Our goal this year is \$74,198. I know we are in the middle of a capital campaign and that you have been very generous in the campaign. Whatever you can give to this year’s appeal is appreciated. If you cannot contribute to the appeal at this time due to our parish campaign, that is also understandable. I hope you know that I am continually grateful for your generosity to SMV.

May the gracious God who is eternally faithful continue to bless each of us.

How do I get the study questions? Study questions will be emailed out to Hosts and individuals who have registered. We will also have a dedicated column in the bulletin with the upcoming study questions.


What is the purpose of the study questions? The questions are just a prompt to start the conversation. Open your hearts and minds and let the Holy Spirit guide your conversations!

Where do the groups meet? In a home, at a coffee shop, or at SMV... whatever works best for the group!


