LENT

- **Lent** is a special time of **prayer** and **fasting** that prepares us for **Easter**. It starts on Ash Wednesday and lasts 40 days (Mon-Sat, excluding Sundays) until the **Easter Vigil**, and reminds us that **Jesus** spent 40 days and nights praying and fasting in the desert where he was tempted by Satan.
- Here are the official U.S.C.C.B. **Rules-for-Fasting**:
 - Ash Wednesday and Fridays during Lent, including Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics.*
 - For Catholics from age 18 until age 59, fasting is obligatory. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.*
- It is **required** for all **Catholics** to **confess** grave sins at least once a year, and highly recommended to confess even venial sins at least once a year. The Lenten season is the perfect time to attend confession especially if you haven't been in a while.
