- A. Liturgy and Encounter (now, Liturgy and Music): Fr. Jerry reported that Franki Moscato has been hired and is onboarding. A meeting was held to discuss Advent preparations (adoration before mass, little blue books, focus cards), Jan mentioned that we intend to have nametags for PPC members to wear at mass to make us more accessible to parishioners.
- B. **Discipleship** Gabe reported a new goal is added for new parishioners to invite a frien; religious ed. program is ready to begin; Bible 101 will meet on Wed evening during same time frame as CGS for the kids. There is some concern about no new families being enrolled in CGS this year. The team will advertise again in the bulletin and at masses.
- C. Evangelization Doug reported they are present at the farmer's market every other week through October; they will potentially hose an Alpha event; the team will be assembling car kits (first aid packages for people begging); the reconciliation retreat had limited attendance, next event scheduled for May 2026.
- D. **Outreach** Lisa reported the next meeting will be pot-luck; they created a sign for St. Peter's Caring Closet and will have students paint a picture for the wall of St. Peter w/ kids; Laurie reached out to Lisa for ideas for

- a Day of Discernment possibly 'Be the hands of Christ'; Laurie and Lisa will host a workshop for Steven Ministry to train ministers; Lisa explained what the ministry is; annual memorial mass will include flowers for infant loss (miscarriage/abortion).
- E. **Relationship** Jan reported they are pulling information to gauge interest in support this team can provide such as help w/ food at events; suggested we need a ministry appreciation dinner, perhaps a potluck.
- F. **Communication** no report, but there was some discussion about how to proceed with virtual communications.
- G. **Prayer Ministry** Nancy reported the prayer team added four new prayer warriors; team is working on communication of prayer intentions, various tools for the team and parish to use to get prayer requests communicated; the phone tree is not up and running yet; Jan and Nancy to get instructional notes added to prayer request boxes/lists. Nancy requested prayer requests from the PPC that we can send to our intercessory prayer team to pray over and we will add it to our monthly PPC agenda.
